Saturday 11th November 1848

First part of these 24 hours fine wind S & by E all sail out Course E by N Middle and latter parts light winds hauler to the S W

Sunday 12th November

Commences with the wind from the N and calm at 5 P M wind turned up Middle fresh Sails from N & W took in steering Sails latter more moderate set the S. S. S. Sails Course E by N

Long 142° 10' West

Monday 13th November

Commences with fresh winds from the N took in steering Sails Course E by N all sail out Middle and latter parts no alterations

Long 140° 00' West

Lat 31° 35' N

Tuesday 14th Nov

First part of these 24 hours repaired at S. S. Sails and then it wind N & W steering sails set Course E & E Middle and latter parts light air from N & W to West

Wednesday 15th Nov

Commences fine all sail out Course E & E then West Middle and latter parts wind W & W to W & W and light

Thursday 16th Nov

First part of these 24 hours light air from the West with fine weather Middle Ruffling air and calm light air latter parts Course E. E. E. wind from N & W to W & W

Friday 17th Nov

Commences with fine weather fine breeze from N & W. Course E. E. E. Middle and latter parts no alterations North repharking

Long 133° 30' West

Lat 31° 43' N

For Cape St Lucas & Maria Island

Saturday 18th November

Commences as usual, wind N & W Course E & E sundown took in steering Sails wind N & by E by the wind to the E by N Middle long winds latter parts took in S. S. Sails and 3/4 jib

Long 131° 45' West

Lat 31° 12' North

Sunday 19th November

Commences with very strong winds from N & E sundown single Reefed the Top Sails Middle parts wind N & by E at daylight took ship to the N & W no alteration in the weather

Long 131° 15' West

Lat 30° 40' N

Monday 20th Nov

Commences as the last ended no alterations; by the wind N. Took S. Middle parts same latter parts took ship to the East wind N & by E

Long 131° 35' West

Tuesday 21st Nov

First part of these 24 hours quite strong then made sail wind North, at Sundown squally Middle parts blew away the main S Sails latter parts steering Sails N & by E by N and Bent New Main Sails

Long 129° 59' West

Lat 31° 17' N

Wednesday 22nd Nov

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze and squally from N & by E all sail out steering Sails N & by Middle and latter parts strong breezes and squally wind rising and hauling 2 points

Long 125° 35' West

Lat 30° 45' N

Thursday 23rd Nov

First part of these 24 hours as usual no alterations in the wind Middle and latter parts wind N & by N by 10 steering full N by cold raw winds and cloudy weather

Friday 24th Nov

No Obs

First part of these 24 hours hazy by the wind to the N & by E all sail out Middle and latter parts wind rising and hauling 2 points from N & W to N & by E by the wind and Course N & by E
