Monday 25<sup>th</sup> December

Commences calm as usual not a breath of air  
and 32 months out. Misch and latter parts had a small plenty of rain latter  
light air repairing Iron Sails

Long 101° 25' W

Lat 15° 10' N

Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> December

Commences fine and calm repairing  
Sails Misch and latter parts calm repairing sails  
Lat 14° 53' N

Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> December

Commences calm as usual repairing  
Sails Misch and latter same

Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> Dec

First part of these 24 hours calm  
Misch very light air latter light breeze Course E.S.E. wind S.E.  
Long 99° 59' West Lat 14° 00'

Friday 29<sup>th</sup> December

Commences fine fine little breeze  
from E by S by the wind went our Old Main Top Sail and Misch stuck  
the steer one Misch and latter parts fine hazying S by E got out the  
Old Harbord Boat on the West Boat-Graves  
Lat

Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> December

Commences with a squall from the S.E.  
tacked ship to the East at sundown fine weather S.E. by the wind  
S.E. Misch - wind baffling latter wind E.S.E. with squalls of  
rain

Long 99° 30'

Lat 12° 12'

# Bound On The Line

Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> December

Commences fine fresh winds from E.S.E.  
all sail set by the wind S.E. Misch and latter parts same  
Lat 10° 52'

Monday 1<sup>st</sup> January 1844

First part of these 24 hours fine light air  
from E.S.E. by the wind to the S.E. of the St. James of London on a  
trading voyage Misch and latter parts nearly calm with rain  
Lat 08°

Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> January

Commences rainy with light air from E.S.E.  
lost the St. James in company Misch and latter parts fresh winds from  
E and E by S and E by S

Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> January

Commences with light winds from the East  
the St. James in sight Misch and latter parts fine breeze from the East  
Long 110° 16' West Lat 8° 42' N

Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> Jan

First part of this day fresh breeze from E by N  
by the wind to the S.E. all sail set Misch and latter no alteration  
Lat 7° 36' N

Friday 5<sup>th</sup> Jan

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze  
by the wind S.E. saw 11 Blackfish however without success Misch stuck in  
top 3 Sails latter set Main Top 5 Sail

Long 99° 36'

Lat 6° 17' N

Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> Jan

First part of this day wind fresh from  
E.S.E. by the wind to the S.E. at sundown took in M. 3<sup>rd</sup> Sail. Misch  
and latter parts no alteration  
Lat 5° 23' N
