

Ship Clifford Wayne of Fairhaven

Sunday January 19th 1844

Commenced fine with fresh breeze from S.E. all sail set by the wind to the S.W. at sundown took in S.E. Sails Middle and bottom parts fine

Long 103° 50' West

Lat 120° N

Saturday Jan 20th

Commenced as usual at sundown took in Top S Sails since S.E. Middle and bottom parts no alteration

Lat 11° 39' N

Sunday Jan 21st

First part strong wind from S.E. hauled by the wind to the S.W. Middle and bottom parts no alteration in weather Long 107° 10' W Lat 11° 17' N

Monday Jan 22nd

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail out by the wind, S.W. at sundown took in T.S. Sails Middle fine since S.E. hauled S.W. bottom parts all sail set

Lat 10° 4' N

Tuesday Jan 23rd

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail out wind S.E. hauled by the wind S.W. at sundown took in Sails Middle parts fine bottom strong trades from S.E. by E by the wind to the South

Long 109° 50' W

Lat 00° 53' N

Wednesday Jan 24th

Commenced with strong trade from S.E. by E by the wind South employed fitting rigging at sundown took in light Sails Doubled Top Sails and Mizen Top Sails

Lat 1° 52' S

Thursday 25th

First part of these 24 hours fine another strong trade from S.E. all sail out by the wind S.W. employed on the rigging Middle parts under short sail bottom parts fine all sail out to the S.W.

Long 112° 18' West

Lat 3° 05' S

Ship Off Tharen (Indonesian)

Sunday 26th January 1844

Commenced fine all sail set by the wind to the S.W. at sundown took in Sails bottom parts fine all sail out by the wind employed on the rigging

Lat 4° 05' S

Saturday 27th Jan

Commenced fine fresh breeze from S.E. by E all sail set by the wind at sundown took in S.E. Sails bottom parts fine Middle parts fine hauled all sail at sundown struck the waste Boat and at 4 past 9 took him alongside struck to the L.B. and Drace so ended Long by Dec 113° 10' West by Dec 5° 10' S

Sunday 28th Jan

Commenced fine getting ready for cutting at 5 finished the Body by the Head all night Middle parts fine bottom parts fine at daylight hooked on and took in the junk at 7 the base is and ready for making at 9 finished and set the masts again

Monday 29th Jan

First part of these 24 hours made sail wind East by the wind to the South and S.E. Middle parts same bottom parts tucked ship to the S.W. employed on the rigging

Long 114° 30' West

Lat 5° 03' S

Tuesday 30th Jan

Commenced fine strong trades on the wind S.E. by E all sail Middle parts no alterations at daylight hooked on and ship to the S.W. and washed off

Lat 4° 30' S

Wednesday 31st Jan

Commenced fine all sail set to the S.W. at sundown took in T.S. Sails Middle and bottom parts strong trades employed at 11 past 10 barrels

Long 115° 38' W

Lat 5° 30' S
