

Ship *Clifford* Wagoner

Thursday 1st February 1844

Commenced with strong trades on the wind South at sundown wore ship to the S & made parts same latter parts broke out after 10 and stowed down

Lat 5° 07' S

Friday 2nd Feb

First part of these 24 hours fair & smooth finished stowing down and found 29th Mat. 16.00 and later by the wind to the S & under 1/2 sails

Long 115° 11' West

Lat 4° 29' S

Saturday 3rd Feb

Commenced with strong trades by the wind S & wind E by S made parts wore ship to the South latter under 1/2 sails & courses

Lat 4° 13' S

Sunday 4th Feb

Commenced with fresh trades on the wind South at sundown took in main sail Middle parts same latter set the main sail with fresh trades

Long 115° 25' West

Lat 5° 13' S

Monday 5th Feb

First part of these 24 hours strong trades by the wind S & W Middle parts no alteration latter parts wore ship to the S & E

Lat 5° 51' S

Tuesday 6th Feb

First part of these 24 hours fair moderate breezes by the wind S & E Middle and latter parts commenced in setting a jibboom

Long 116° 51' West

Lat 5° 20' S

Wednesday 7th Feb

First part of this day quite moderate all sail set & under 1/2 sails Middle and latter parts fair light winds from E by S rigged out small jibboom

Lat 4° 43' S

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First part of these 24 hours making fore & S Mast out of our old jibboom at sundown took 1/2 Sails Middle and latter parts fair weather making fore & S Mast and getting rigging

Lat 3° 56' S

Friday 9th February

First of this day fine all sail at Course at 10 at sundown took in the 1/2 Sails and kept 1/2 Sails Middle and latter parts made all sail Course S & W saw

Long 117° 40' W

Lat 3° 21' S

Saturday 10th Feb

First part of these 24 hours fine Course S & W all sail set Middle parts by the wind S & E latter made sail Course S & W

Lat 3° 57' S

Sunday 11th Feb

First of this day Course S & W at sundown took in 1/2 Sails by the wind to the S & E through the Middle and latter made sail Course S & W Long 118° 46' W

Lat 2° 48' S

Monday 12th Feb

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail at Course at 10 wind S & E Middle parts by the wind S & E latter parts Course S & W sent up the fore & S Mast

Lat 3° 08' S

Tuesday 13th Feb

First of this day fine all sail on the rigging Course S & W at sundown by the wind S & E Middle and latter parts fine

Long 120° 05' W

Lat 1° 19' S

Wednesday 14th Feb

First part of this day fine spoke ship *Splendid* of Edgartown 4 months out 25th June Middle and latter parts fine at work on the rigging
