Thursday 15th February 1844

First part of this day fine Course S W all sail out wind S E (Mistral) and latter part by the wind to the South

Lat 2° 36' N. Long 120° 50' W

Friday 16th Feb

First part of this day fine all sail out by the wind at 4 saw Blackfish. However without success. (Mistral) under short sail latter all sail set to the South

Long 120° 50' W Lat 1° 15' S

Saturday 17th Feb

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail out by the wind crew deerside duty because they could not have soft tongs. At sundown took in S S Sails Middle and latter part by the wind

Lat 2° 15' S

Sunday 18th Feb

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail out by the wind S W Middle and latter part fresh trader Course S W by S all sail out

Long 121° 30' W Lat 3° 00'

Monday 19th Feb

First part of this day Course S W by S at 8 raised a short of (Mistral) however and struck 1 to the L B Chassis without success at sundown took him alongside at 8 the other 2 Boats came on Board (Mistral) got ready latter part took him in made sail Course S W

Lat 2° 34' S

Tuesday 20th Feb

First part Boiling at sundown made Course S W Middle part finished Boiling latter part made all sail Course S W washed off the decks part away for (Mistral)

Long 126° 40' W Lat 2° 30' S

On Off Shore from (Mistral)

Wednesday 21st February 1844

Commenced fine with Moderate Trades all sail out Course S W by S at sundown Course S W by W Middle and latter part same employed in turning up (Mistral) Rigger

Lat 3° 00' S

Thursday 22nd Feb

First part Moderate Trades all sail out Course S W by W Middle and latter part fine all sail set

Long 130° 16' West Lat 3° 56' S

Friday 23rd Feb

First part fine Breeze all sail set Course S W by W Middle and latter part fine no alteration in wind or weather finished (Mistral) Rigger and various other jobs

Lat 4° 49' S

Saturday 24th Feb

First part of this day wind and weather fine Course S W by W Middle and latter part no alteration

Long 134° 00' W Lat 5° 41' S

Sunday 25th Feb

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail set Course S W by W Middle and latter part fine no alteration

Long Lat 6° 50'

Monday 26th Feb

First part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather all sail set Course S W by W Middle and latter part fine employed in stowing down between decks (Mistral) and (Mistral)

Long 137° 15' West Lat 7° 33' S

Tuesday 27th Feb

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail set Course S W by West Middle and latter part fine all sail out Course S W by W employed at ship's duty

Long 138° 42' West Lat 8° 25' S
