Wednesday 17th April 1847

First part of these 24 hours fine light breeze from West all sail set, course E S E Middle part Calm latter part Strong Breezes from S E by the wind to the E S E under Top Sails & Courses

Long 142° 30 West Lat 41° 12 South

Thursday 18th April

First part of these 24 hours strong S E winds & Tacks Middle part from Moderate latter part Calm No Obs

Friday 19th April

First part of these 24 hours Calm took up our sheathing and scraped the decks Middle part Breezes from the S E to S W latter part same course E S E

Long 139° 50 West Lat 41° 14 S

Saturday 20th April

First part of these 24 hours winds from N E W and West all sail set Middle part fresh Sails latter wind from W more Moderate all sail out course E S E

Long 136° 53 Lat 42° 18

Sunday 21st April

First part of these 24 hours fine breeze from N W all sail out course E S E Middle wind from the S E took in Staining Sails latter thick weather under Top Sails and Courses to thick No Obs

Monday 22nd April

First part of these 24 hours thick rainy weather wind from E S E by the wind S E all sail set Middle rainy latter part wind S E and cloudy Long 133° 27 Lat 41° 20 S

Tuesday 23rd April

First part of these 24 hours quite clear wind S E by the wind all sail out at Sundown took ship to the South wind E S E all sail set and cloudy

Lat 42° 16 South

Wednesday 24th April 1847

First of these 24 hours fresh breezes from E by S all sail set by the wind S E by S Middle part took in main Top Sails latter part same wind from E S E at noon took ship to the S E

Thursday 25th April

First part of these 24 hours wind hauling to the South by the wind E S E all sail out Middle part light air latter part light wind from N W course E S E all sail out staining Sails all

Long 131° 35 Lat 43° 18

Friday 26th April

First part of this day fresh Breezes from N W course E S E Middle part wind from N W and thick latter breeze from N S W and same Long 128° 19 W Lat 45° 33

Saturday 27th April

First part of these 24 hours strong gales from S W all sail set course E S E at Sundown took in main Top Sails latter part fine latter same all sail out

Long 125° 25 West Lat 46° 40

Sunday 28th April

First part of this day strong Breezes from S W all sail out course E S E Middle and latter part fresh Breezes from N S W and N W by S all sail out course E S E

Long 121° 03 West Lat 47° 56

Monday 29th April

First part of these 24 heavy squalls of rain & Hail from S S W at 13 strong gale Doubled Reef Top Sails course East at Sundown closed Reefs the Top Sails Middle part in morning Top Sails Heavy squalls of Hail latter part Heavy squalls of snow course E by S wind N and N S W

Long 117° 21 West Lat 47° 53 South

Very uncomfortable weather
