First part of these 24 hours fine light
air from S W Course at 8 by 10 inside Main Sail and then it
Middle part fine little breeze from the S E. Latter part light
air & calm

Long 30° 50 West Lat 27° 10 S

Wednesday 5th June

First part of these 24 hours fine; calm
then the Mizzen 1/2 S Sail and 1/2 S Sail making out after Hatch way
and shaking empty Baskets middle part Calm Latter parts
Calm had 1/2 S Sail down watch below Dreamer of Sailing H.A.S.

Long 30° 44 West Lat 26° 50 S

Thursday 6th June

First part of these 24 hours Calm
middle part Calm & light wind latter part same air from the North
of the wind to the East

Long 30° 24 West Lat 26° 30 S

Friday 7th June

First part of these 24 hours fine
weather light air from S W Course at 8 by 10 and 1/2 S Sail at Ship's Duty
Middle part light breeze latter light air and calm & shift in light
staring to the S E

Long 29° 34 West Lat 25° 40 S

Saturday 8th June

First part of these 24 hours fine calm
the 2 Ship about 4 miles off employed on the Rigger Middle & latter part
light wind from the S E and then about by the wind to the North
& sail in light

Long 29° 43 West Lat 25° 10 S

Sunday 9th June

First part of these 24 hours
Calm & light air from the S E Middle part light wind from S E
and Calm latter part fine little breeze from S E by the wind
to the North and S E

Long 30° 00 West Lat 24° 36 South

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Monday 10th June 1844

First part of these 24 hours fine light
air from S E & all sail out by the wind at 8 by 10 Middle
part by 10 latter same all sail set employed on the Rigger

Long 30° 14 West Lat 23° 40 S

Tuesday 11th June

First part of these 24 hours fine
breeze from S E by 10 by the wind at 10 Sails Middle part fine
breeze from S E & latter fresh breeze from East

Long 30° 40 Lat 22° 12 S

Wednesday 12th June

Commences with fresh breeze
course at 8 by 10 all sail out Middle & latter part by the wind
from S E at 8

Long 30° 59 West Lat 20° 00 S

Thursday 13th

First part of these 24 hours fresh trade
the wind from S E at 8 by 10 all sail out Middle & latter part
by 10 Sails

Long 31° 09 West Lat 18° 02 S

Friday 14th June

First part of these 24 hours fine
by the wind at 8 by 10 & 1/2 S Sail at 8 by 10 Middle and
latter parts no alterations employed about the Rigger nothing down

Long 31° 32 West Lat 16° 24 S

Saturday 15th June

First part of these 24 hours fine
trade in S W Sail strong trade from S E by 10 by the wind
Middle and latter parts by the wind at 8 by 10

Long 32° 00 West Lat 14° 40 S

Sunday 16th June

First part of these 24 hours
light wind from S E by 10 Middle and latter parts no
alterations by the wind at 8 by 10 Sails

Long 32° 35 West Lat 13° 35 S
