

Ship Clifford Wayne

Saturday 29th June 1844

First part of these 24 hours strong
Sails from S.W. Ast. in steering sail at dark took in S.W. Middle
part of Sails Course at W. Middle and latter part more moderate
with sail out Long 39° 35' Lat 10° 05'

Sunday 30th June

First part of these 24 hours light air
and calms from all points of the compass Middle part wind
from the S.W. latter part strong S.W. Trades Course at W. by S
all sail set and ship made steering sail

Long 41° 00' West Lat 11° 30' N

Monday 1st July

First part of these 24 hours strong
Trades from S.E. Course at W. by S Middle and latter part
Course at W. latter washing ship for painting

Long 42° 30' West Lat 13° 26' N

Tuesday 2nd July

First part of these 24 hours fine
all sail set Course at W. finished washing ship already for painting
Middle part strong Trades latter part same finished painting
Hull and commenced on the inside of bow at W.

Long 46° West Lat 15° 08' N

Wednesday 3rd July

First part of these 24 hours
Strong Trades all sail out Course at W. employed in painting
ship inside Middle part wind East latter part S.W. and S
strong

Long 48° 45' West Lat 16° 44' N

Thursday 4th July

First part of this day strong Trades
from S.E. everything set finished painting inside Course at W.
Middle and latter part more moderate employed in painting
and finishing ship and Long 51° 00' West Lat 18° 51' N

Ship Fairhaven

Friday 5th July 1844

First part of these 24 hours set the
latter strong sail under S.W. and fine weather Middle -
latter wind S.W. latter part S.W. again in fresh Course at W.
Long 53° 31' West Lat 20° 09' North

Saturday 6th July

First part of these 24 hours fine
all sail out Course at W. wind falling off broke out after
Hatch way and stowed off again Middle and latter part fine
breeze from East

Long 55° 24' West Lat 21° 35' N

Sunday 7th July

First part of these 24 hours fine Trades
from the East all sail out Course at W. saw a sail steering
to the West Middle and latter part fine Trades from the East
and fine weather

Long 57° 36' West Lat 23° 10' N

Monday 8th July

First part of these 24 hours fine
Trades from the East all sail that can be set is set Course
at W. Middle and latter part light winds from S.E.

Long 59° 15' West Lat 24° 25' N

Tuesday 9th July

First part of these 24 hours fine
employed on the Rigging and various other jobs
with light wind from the S.E. Middle and latter part
no alterations Course at W. Long 60° 24' West Lat 25° 29' N

Wednesday 10th July

First part of these 24 hours fine
pleasant weather all sail out Course at W. painting ship outside
long in sight steering to the S.W. Middle and latter part light
breeze from the S.E. to S.W. employed in painting
ship outside and hoping for a fresh breeze
