

Ship Clifford Wayne On Her

Thursday 11th July 1844

First part of these 24 hours

light breezes from the E & E and fine weather all sail
out Course & W. Middle part fine with breezes latter part
light air parting outside Long

Lat 29° 20' N

Friday 12th July

First part of these 24 hours

light air from the S & E finished parting ship inside
and outside Middle part fine light air from the S & E
breeze & W 3 sail in light Long 63° 41' West Lat 28° 10'

Saturday 13th July

First part of these 24 hours fine light

air from the S & E Course & W. Ship in company steering E by N by N
Middle and latter parts light wind from the S & E and South

Long 64° 45' West Lat 28° 56'

Sunday 14th July

First part of these 24 hours light air

and calm Middle part light wind from the W & W latter wind
from the W & E all sail out by the wind

Long 65° 18' West Lat 29° 55'

Monday 15th July

First part of these 24 hours strong wind

from W & W to W all drawing sail set at 5 took in S & M S & Sails
and by S & E Course & W by E Middle part squally latter part light
wind from the S & W all sail out

Long 66° 29' West Lat 30° 20' N

Tuesday 16th July

First part of these 24 hours fine light

wind from the S & W all sail out Course & E & W employed
in scraping decks Middle part nearly calm latter part fine
breeze from the West by the wind 1 brig in sight steering
to the E & W

Long 67° 04' Lat 32° 53'

Passage to Fairhaven

Wednesday 17th July 1844

First part of these 24 hours fresh breezes

from the W & W set the steering Sails Middle part strong
breezes from the S & W took in steering Sails and Royals
latter parts same Course & W by E watch and by S at
Pumping Ship Long 68° 50' West Lat 35° 02' N

Thursday 18th July

First part of these 24 hours strong

breeze took in top Sails with a little rain employed at Pumping
Ship about all the time Middle part wind fell off and rainy
latter parts light air from the S & E Course & W by E

Long 69° 36' West Lat 36° 13' N

Friday 19th July

First part of these 24 hours light

wind from the S & E and E & E Middle part strong breezes from
the E & E with 2 hours hard rain at daylight fine with moderate
breezes from the E & E passed a brig steering to the S & W

Long Lat 37° 30' N

Saturday 20th July

First part of these 24 hours fine

light wind from the E & E had our log works Over Board
Middle part fresh breezes from the S & W latter part semi spoke
the Schooner Megab of Boston 4 days from Connecticut bound
to W Long 70° 58' West Lat 39° 02'

Sunday 21st July

First part of these 24 hours strong

breezes from the S & W Course & E by W every thing set Course
by W and thick Middle part foggy latter part cleared
with a light breeze from the West

Long 71° 13' West Lat 40° 20' N

Monday 22nd July

First part of this day light air boarded

brig Pandora of Boston Middle part light air from the S & W
and S Course & E by W 2 Pilot B in sight Lat 41° 04' N
