Fore part of these 24 hours fine Breezes from the S.E. Leading E at 3 P.M. leading E & S Middle parts light winds latter parts same getting boats and breeching out.

Fore part of these 24 hours Cloudy and light airs from the S.E. to S Middle parts light wind leading E & S and E by S latter parts same breaking out and getting boats

Fore part of these 24 hours strong wind from the S.S.W. Course S.E. by E under Double Reef Top Sails Middle parts strong gales took in Main Sail latter gales from the S.S.W. under Close Reef Top Sails Leading S.E.

Fore part of these 24 hours a gale from the S.W. Leading S.E. under Close Reef Top Sails Leading S.E. Middle parts wind hauled suddenly to the N.E. Middle parts took the Main Top Sail latter parts under Double Reef Top Sails and courses, Course S.E. by E

Make Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> Jan

Fore part of these 24 hours fresh Breezes from E & S Leading S.E. Middle parts wind hauled to the South near Ship the East latter parts fine weather all sail set

Lat 34° 22' N Long 42° 06' West

Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> Jan

Fore part of these 24 hours fine weather moderate Breezes from the S.E. Leading E by S Middle parts same latter parts no alteration leading East fine weather saw 1 Sail and fragments

Lat 34° 56' N Long 40° 16' West

Monday 24<sup>th</sup> Jan

Fore part of these 24 hours fine weather Breezes from the S.E. all sail set leading East at sundown took in Main Top Sail Middle and latter parts fine weather leading S.E.

Fore part of these 24 hours fine weather moderate Breezes from the South Leading E & S sent up our cuttingendants saw a Steamship steering East saw a Sail steering S.E. Middle parts hazy S.E. latter parts wind S.W. reefed the Top Sails

Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> Jan

Fore part of these 24 hours strong Breezes from the S.W. Course S.E. at 3 P.M. Double Reef took in Main Sail and jib Middle parts wind hauled to the North with heavy rains latter parts fresh Breezes
