Thursday 3rd Feb

Fore part of these 24 hours fine weather light breezes from the South all sail out heading to the W. S. W. put out new west side Middle and latter parts wind light heading S. W. by W. breaking out between decks

Friday 4th Feb

Fore part of these 24 hours heavy swell from the West light winds from the S. E. heading to the S. W. by W. Middle and latter parts same breaking out between decks

Lat 26° 51' N Long by Chron 25° 17' West

Saturday 5th Feb

Fore part of these 24 hours brisk Breezes from the S. E. at 2 P. M. tacked Ship to the East Middle parts laying S. E. by S. latter parts same backing up spars

Sunday 6th Feb

Fore part of these 24 hours Moderate Breezes from the S. E. tacked Ship to the S. W. brig in sight heading to the East Middle parts same latter parts Calm

Fore part of these 24 hours light breezes from the S. E. heading South thick hazy weather Middle parts same latter parts same saw a ship steering West employed at setting of rigging Course South Lat 24° 50' N Long by Chron 24° 25' West

Fore part fresh winds Course South Middle parts same latter strong trades Lat 22° 24' N Long by Chron 23° 54' W
