From part of these 24 hours strong gales from the West Course E & S. Much and latter part strong gals

Lat 40° 05' S Long 110° 41' E

Sunday 14th May

From part of these 24 hours strong gales from the West Course E & S. Middle and latter parts from moderate

Lat 40° 29' S Long 113° 42' E

Monday 15th May

From part of these 24 hours freshened from the West to N.W. Course E & S. Middle parts closed. Much the top sails a gale from the West. Latter part Rail squalls

Lat 41° 14' S Long 117° 45' E

Tuesday 16th May

From part of these 24 hours a gale from the West under Close. Reefs & Main top sails & fore sail Course E & S. Middle and latter parts a gale with heavy squalls of hail

Lat 41° 45' S Long 122° 00' E

Wednesday 17th May

From part of this day a gale from W & W under Close & Reefs & fore sail Course E & S. Middle parts squally. Latter parts wind W & W more moderate under Double Reefs

Lat 42° 20' S Long 125° 44' E

Thursday 18th May

From part of these 24 hours overcast moderate breeze from W & W Course E & S. Middle and latter parts wind W & W more moderate

Lat 43° 12' S Long 129° 34' E

Friday 19th May

First part fine weather moderate winds from W & W Course E & S. All sail set Middle parts same latter part thick weather wind North

Lat by Acct 43° 35' S Long by Acct 132° 00'

From part of these 24 hours light winds from the North with foggy weather Middle and latter parts same all sail set

Lat 44° 20' S Long by Acct 135° 37' E

Sunday 21st May

First part strong winds from the North all sail set thick weather Course East. Much and latter parts same

Lat 44° 53' S Long 140° 35' E

Monday 22nd May

From part of these 24 hours more clear strong winds from W & W Course East at sundown. Reefs & top sails middle parts, raising latter parts strong winds thick & rainy. Colored Reefs & top sails Course E & S. Lat by Acct 45° 29' S Long Acct 144° 49'

Tuesday 23rd May

From part of these 24 hours more moderate thick & rainy Course E & S. Middle parts clear off latter parts with gales from W & W Course E & S. Saw a whale ship steering to the E & S

Lat 45° 37' S Long 149° 35' E

Wednesday 24th May

From part of these 24 hours fresh gales from the West Course E & S under Double Reefs & top sails Course Middle parts moderate. Made sail latter parts fine weather Course E & S. Ship in company

Lat 43° 37' S Long by Acct 152° 12' E

Thursday 25th May

From part of these 24 hours fine light wind from the W & W Course E & S. Middle and latter parts fine weather all sail set Course E & S by W & S. Wind W & W

Lat 41° 38' S Long 154° 27' E

Friday 26th May

From part of these 24 hours moderate wind from W & W Course E & S. Middle parts calm latter parts same fine pleasant weather
