parts equally latter parts heading S.W.

Sunday 16th July

and S.E. heading to the S at sundown Reef Top Sails Middle parts
were reef to the S.E. and latter were to the South

N.W. by S latter parts same cloudy weather Lat 17° 46' Long 176° 02' E

Saturday 22nd July

From part of these 24 hours heading S.E. & E
at 5 P.M. wore Ship to the S.W. under Reef Top Sails Middle
latter parts strong trades heading S.W.

Lat 18° 31' S Long 69° 17' E

Sunday 23rd July

From part of these 24 hours cloudy strong
trades heading S.W. at sundown reef the Top Sails Middle and
latter parts same course S.W. by S

Lat 20° 02' S Long 69° 17' E

Monday 24th July

From part of these 24 hours fresh trades
from East Course S.W. at sundown Reef Top Sails Middle
latter parts all sail set Course S.W. 1 sail in sight

Lat by Oct 21° 48' S Long Oct 173° 30' E

Tuesday 25th July

From part of these 24 hours rain strong
winds from the East at sundown took in sail heading South
Middle parts rain latter parts strong winds under Double Reef heading
S.W. Huntus bearing N.W. by N distant 25 miles
