

Ship Clifford Wayne of Fairhaven

Wednesday 6th Sept. 1848

From part of fine took our whale alongside at 1 P.M. struck the Starboard Boat and the Starboard Boat got cut in two cut from the whale, at 3 struck the same one again at sundown cut and let him go took in sail heading South by fine pleasant weather light air from N.W. Middle part better same at 6 P.M. commenced cutting at 12 finished

Lat 28°30' S Long 68° 15' 30" E

Current setting S.W. E

Thursday 7th Sept

From part cleared up and commenced work Middle part blowing strong took in sail wind N.W. Course S.W. latter part blowing moderate heading S.P.W. repairing Boat current strong

Lat 28°37' S Long 68° 15' 24" E

Friday 8th Sept

From part of these 24 hours fine wind N.W. heading to the South blowing Middle part wind S.E. saw 2 whales steering to the North latter part finished blowing

Lat 28°15' S Long 68° 15' 10" E

Current North strong Saturday 9th Sept

From part of fine light wind from E.S.E. Course S.P.W. Middle part same latter part calm steering down main Hatch 47.000 lb from Oil

Lat 28°00' S Long 68° 15' 07" E

Sunday 10th Sept

From part of these 24 hours calm Middle part light wind from S.P.E. latter part fresh breezes heading S.W. by N.W.

Lat 27°57' S Long 68° 15' 39" E

Monday 11th Sept

From part of fresh breezes from South by the wind N.W. at night took in sail Middle and latter part fine weather all sail set wind S.W. by S saw a sail

Lat 28°00' S Long 68° 15' 33" E

On New Holland Steam Whaling

Thursday 12th September 1848

From part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather light wind from S.W. heading S.P.E. Middle part Course S.W. by N.W. latter part strong wind from S.W. heading to the West

Lat 28°42' S Long 68° 15' 23" E

Wednesday 13th Sept

From part of these 24 hours strong wind from South heading N.W. at sundown wore ship to the East Middle and latter part fine weather light wind from South

Lat 29°16' S Long 68° 15' 49" E

Thursday 14th Sept

From part of these 24 hours fine weather light wind from South Middle and latter part light breeze from West Course S.W. by W

Lat 29°50' S Long 68° 15' 52" E

Friday 15th Sept

From part of these 24 hours fine fine breeze from N.W. heading N.W. Middle part same latter heading N.W. by S strong wind

Lat 30°28' S Long 68° 15' 35" E

Saturday 16th Sept

From part of these 24 hours fresh gales at 4 P.M. wore ship to the N.E. and took in sail closed Reefs main & 2nd sail took in fore sail Middle part a gale at daylight and hauled to the South and moderated

Lat 30°28' S Long 68° 15' 21" E

Sunday 17th Sept

From part of these 24 hours moderate wind from S Course N.W. at sundown took in sail Middle and latter part fine weather Course West

Lat 30°00' S Long 68° 15' 23" E

Monday 18th Sept

From part of fine light wind from the South steering West at sundown wore ship to the N.E. Middle part wore to the S.E. wind N.E. latter part strong wind from the North heading E.S.E.
