Thursday 2^d November 1848

From part light wind from N.E. Middle
part wind N.E. & latter part same Cloudy weather leading East

Lat 33° 48' S Long 165° 00' E

Friday 3^d November

From part strong wind from N.E. to E. & an
rainy leading to the East Middle and latter part same

and Double Reef to the East Lat 33° 30' S Long 166° 30' E

Saturday 4th November

From part of these 24 hours Cloudy wind N.E.
to N.W. under Reef 1/2 of sails at sundown took in sail leading N.E. by

Middle same latter part wind from N.E. leading N.E. to W

Lat 34° 30' S Long 166° 30' E

Sunday 5th November

From part of this day rainy thick weather
light wind from N.E. Middle part wind N.E. to W leading N.E. to E
latter part fresh breezes and equally leading N.E. to E at 9 A.M. saw
Green Whales going quick to the S.E. at 10. lowered and chased down
at noon came on board Lat 34° 29' S Long 167° 06' E



Monday 6th November

From part strong wind from West at
2 P.M. lowered again and struck to the Landward Boat
at 6 P.M. took him alongside leading S.E. by S wind S.W.
Middle part strong wind latter part same and rugged at 6 A.M.
commenced cutting at noon finished

Tuesday 7th November

From part fine wind S.W. and Mod-
erate cleared up and commenced Boiling Middle part light
wind latter part fresh breeze from N.W. leading N.E. to E
Boiling saw Timber

Lat 34° 00' S Long 168° 04' E

Wednesday 8th November

From part fine breeze from N.W. at 4 P.
M. saw Ship to the N.W. Middle part same rain latter part
wind S.W. leading to the S.W. fine Boiling saw Timber

Lat 34° 15' S Long 167° 28' E

Thursday 9th November

From part of this day fine fine breeze
S.W. leading S.W. Middle part fine latter part same
leading N.E. wind S.E. Lat 34° 14' S Long 167° 15' E

Friday 10th November

From part fine weather wind S.E. by
leading to the N.E. Middle part wind N.E. leading to the S.E. latter
part fine light wind stored down Main Hatchway 50 The Green Oil

Lat 34° 10' S Long 167° 45' E

Saturday 11th November

From part light wind from the N.W. heavy
the N.E. to E Middle and latter part fine weather saw Harpoon & Fish
at N.E. to W

Lat 34° 00' S Long 169° 10' E

Sunday 12th Nov

From part of these 24 hours fine breeze
N.E. by E wind N.E. to W Middle part very light wind latter part
fine breeze N.E. by W leading N.E. to E to E (strong current to the East)

Lat 34° 03' S Long 170° 46' E

Monday 13th Nov

From part fine breeze from the N.E.
leading N.E. to E Middle part fine latter part light winds
and heavy

Lat 34° 13' S Long 171° 50' E

Tuesday 14th Nov

From part of these 24 hours rainy at
2 P.M. saw three Kings bearing S.E. by E distant 20 miles
Middle and latter part calm late in sight heavy S.E. by S

Wednesday 15th Long 171° 56'

From part calm and rainy late 15 miles
N.E. by S Middle and latter part cloudy weather leading to the N.W.
