Saturday 2^d December

From part fine wind N of the S and S
Francis Fairham Capt Wood 11 months out 50th of June
Middle part fresh breezes latter part rainy wind shifted to
the N W to South rainy Long 158° 56'

Sunday 3^d December

From part cleared off fresh wind from
the South in company S E leading to the West Middle part same
latter part fine same Whales to windward saw the S to the
dove support of the Whales Brown to be Humphreys
Lat 36° 19' S Long 158° 03' E

Monday 4th Dec

From part fine light wind from South
Middle part same latter part fresh breezes from the East leading
to the N E thick and rainy Lat 36° 00' S Long 158° 13'

Tuesday 5th Dec

From part of these 24 hours rain
East leading N E & Middle part same latter part rainy
wind N W to W S W took in sail
Lat 36° 13' S Long 158° 51' E

Wednesday 6th Dec

From part cleared off more moderate
made sail leading S E wind N S W Middle part same latter
part strong wind took in sail
Lat 36° 11' S Long 159° 45'

Thursday 7th Dec

From part of this day strong N S W
wind leading to the South Middle and latter part S W
strong wind
Lat 37° 11' S Long 159° 25' E

Friday 5th December 1848

From part strong wind N E W leading
West at dawn more ship N E Middle part fine latter
part light wind from the South Course N W by E
Lat 36° 50' S Long 159° 24' E

Saturday 9th Dec

From part of these 24 hours fine fine
breezes from S E steering N W Middle leading to the N E
latter part wind N E to E leading to the West fine weather
Lat 35° 35' S Long 158° 50' E

Sunday 10th Dec

From part of this day fine fresh
breezes N E W leading N S W which wind S W latter wind
from S E to S S W and squally
Lat same Long 159° 14' E

Monday 11th December

From part of these 24 hours strong wind
from the S S E leading to the East spoke the Emie Hobartown
10 months out 120th of June Oil Middle and latter part fine
in sight
Lat 35° 40' S Long 158° 46' E

Tuesday 12th Dec

From part of these 24 hours fine calm
in sight Middle calm latter light wind from the West
spoke the Cabiton Packet Capt Shannan 38 months 1600
Lat 36° 00' S Long 159° 26' E

Wednesday 13th Dec

From part light wind from the West
Middle same latter light wind from the N W spoke the J. J. Sana
Hobartown 10 days out Cabiton Packet in sight
Lat 36° 23' S Long 159° 25' E

Thursday 14th

From part fine light wind North Middle
part same latter part fine breezes leading N W
Lat 35° 53' S Long 159° 22'
