From part fine heading S^W E wind
East at sundown took in sail S M in sight Middle and latter
parts fine weather heading S^W

Thursday 22nd Feb

From part of this day fine heading S^W
at 5 P. M. wore ship to the S^W Middle and latter parts
strong winds from S^W E heading S^W

Friday 23rd Feb

From part of these 24 hours strong
winds from S^W E heading S^W spoke lines S^W 1 masted
since last I saw him Middle parts same heading S^W latter parts
strong wind and squally under Double Keel S by Sails

Saturday 24 Feb 1849

From part strong winds from the S^W E and being
ship to the S^W under short sail at sundown took in sail Middle
parts latter parts short sail strong current and plenty of rips

Sunday 25th Feb

From part of these 24 hours fine weather nearly calm with
heavy swell from the S^W Middle and latter parts same

Lat 33 10 Long 170 00 E

Monday 26th Feb

From part of these 24 hours light air from the
West and a heavy swell from the East Middle light wind course S^W E
latter parts all sail sail course S^W E

Lat 33 36 S Long 170 45 E

Tuesday 27th Feb

From part of this day fine light wind from
the S^W E course East Middle and latter parts fine weather light
wind from S^W to S^W saw 3 Shoals Blackfish

Lat 33 02 S Long 171 31 E

Wednesday 28th February

From part of these 24 hours fine weather
light winds from the Westward course East Middle and latter parts
fine

Lat by Dec 33 00 Long by Dec 173 25

Thursday 1st March

From part of these 24 hours breeze from
S^W E and headed to the North wore ship to the S^W E making
Middle parts light air and heavy rains latter parts thick air rainy

Lat by Dec 32 53 S Long by Dec 172 50

Friday 2nd March

From part heavy and thick no wind at
sundown. Headed Middle parts cloudy latter parts wind west then
fine weather course East
