

Ship Clifford Wayne Fairhaven

Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> June 1849

From part of these 24 hours fine moderate winds S.W. at sundown barometer distant 4 miles from ship to the S.E. the S. mass well in company middle part calm bar too low off latter part steering along shore to the S.W. side with light winds off the land

Lat 38° 38' off the shore Long 173° 49'

Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> June

From part fine beating up to the port with light winds from the S.E. at sundown entrance 4 miles off laying off the on at daylight took a Pilot & stood in Beating up at 11 A.M. came too in 27 fathoms weather came out 29<sup>th</sup> got altitudes off the Head

Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> June

From part of these 24 hours fine middle part same at daylight got underweigh and stood out in company with the M. Lat 41° 44' Head 1841 Long 173° 44'

Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> June

From part fine wind East steering S.W. at sundown Almaguera Bar S.W. by S. distant 20 miles and the other S.W. 10 miles middle part fine latter parts same steering S.W. Lat 16° 51' S Long 175° 00' W

Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> July

From part fine wind S.E. Course S.W. by E at sundown steering West W. middle fine latter steering S.W. wind S.E. by E

Lat 15° 24' S Long 176° 34' W

Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July

From part fresh winds S.E. Course S.W. by E middle part equally latter part heading W. by S wind S.W. to S.W. and very light

Lat 15° 10' S Long 177° 15'

On River Holland

Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 1849

From part fine light winds from the West ending to the S.W. 4 saw the land bearing S.W. by S. about 50 miles and latter parts same S.W. point 9 miles

Lat 14° 01' S Long 178° 02'

Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> July

From part fine there trading middle and latter parts same

Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> July

From part fine middle and latter to same same on Board and spoke off

Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July

From part fine weather steering off sundown course S.W. by S middle and latter parts with wind from S.E. Lat 15° 17' Long 179° 08' West

Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> July

From part fine wind S.E. Course S.W. at 2 saw Linnell Island bearing S.W. by S distant 30 miles and steering in latter parts in off the Head Lat 16° 06' S Long 179° 04' West

Daily rate 17/10

Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> July

From part fine at 4 off the north of the S.W. off long above at sundown laying aboard under the with S. Linnell middle and latter parts fine weather steering along to the West Lat 16° 33' S Long 179° 01'

177 35 Star course

Monday 9<sup>th</sup> July

From part of this day fresh winds in the East steering to the S.W. off Linnell Island middle and latter parts steering for Linnell Island and passed Lat about 16° 50' Long
