Tuesday 24th July 1849

Fore part fine moderate breeze from S
Course was made part fine under short sail latter part S
in sight Course 26th S. Lat 24° 15' S Long 167° 07' E
Sun by S.M. 21.32 Rise and set 166° 41' E
Old En 23° 16' from 10 July 27.53

Wednesday 25th July

Fore part fine weather Course N by S
Spoke the Joseph at sundown took in sail heading to the North
about middle part steered off N by S wind North

Lat 24° 25' S Long 166° 03' E

Thursday 26th July

Fore part squalls from the West heading to
the S under double reef middle part wind hauled to the S by W
more ship to West latter strong wind from the South Course N by S

Lat 24° 21' S Long 165° 04' E

Long by Loran 164° 41' E made Error 21° 50' Sun West Dist 79° 00' 00"

Friday 27th July

Fore part of this day strong wind from the
South Course N by W under reef S by W in sight middle and latter
part steering S by W N by W N by W wind S E Long 162° 45'

Lat 24° 26' S Long by Loran 162° 42' E gave Error 21° 19' Dist 90° 00'

Saturday 28th July

Fore part fine wind S E Course S by W
took in sail middle and latter part fine heading to the N by S
fine weather wind light from East Lat 24° 41' S Long 161° 55' E
Loran 161° 52' E by Error 21° 20' Sun Error

Sunday 29th July

Fore part fine weather light air from
the East heading S by W middle part wind hauled to the N by S
to the West latter part wind S by W more ship to the West
fresh breezes under double reef

Lat 25° 00' S Long 161° 27' E

Monday 30th July 1849

Fore part of this day fresh breezes
from the South heading N by W plenty of clouds middle and
latter part heading to the S by W

Lat 24° 56' S Long 160° 35' E

Tuesday 31st July

Fore part of these 24 hours fine weather wind
the heading on the western tack at sundown took in sail middle
to fine weather latter part equally heading West

Lat 24° 56' S Long 160° 14' E

Wednesday 1st August

Fore part of these 24 hours squally weather
sundown took in sail heading West middle part heavy squalls
from the South took in fore sail latter part under close reef

Sails heading N by W Lat 24° 45' S Long 159° 12' E

Thursday 2nd August

Fore part of these 24 hours fresh gales and
squally from the South heading N by W at sundown took in sail
latter moderate latter part light winds more ship to the E S E

Lat 24° 28' S Long 159° 01' E

Friday 3rd August

Fore part fine light winds from the South
began tack middle S by S latter part fine light winds
S by W

Lat 24° 42' S Long 159° 27' E

Saturday 4th August

Fore part fine wind S by W heading
E middle S to S by W latter part S E fine weather

Lat 25° 17' S Long 159° 36' E

Sunday 5th

Fore part fine wind S by E more ship
to S by W middle part heading S by S latter part heading
N by W light winds from E S E
