did not leave from part of this day strong winds from W & W heading to the S. W. very rough under short sail at 2 P. M. saw sperm Whales going quick to the West saw then 2 rising & and must out of sight Middle part fine weather calm at 7 P. M. saw sperm Whales going South lowered the Boats but could not get near them chasing

Thursday 13th Sept 1849

calm breeze from the West. Some part of this day fine breeze from the North chasing whales to the North but could not get up with them at sundown took in sail heading West Middle and latter part fine weather light winds from the North

Lat 26 26 S Long 158 37 E

Friday 14th Sept

Some part of this day came up squally with thunder & lightning at 5 P. M. wind from all parts heavy rains wind S. W. to N. W. latter part more ships to the W. & W. strong wind and rough

Lat 26 26 S Long 158 53

Saturday 15th Sept

Some part of these 24 hours moderate wind headed to the S. & W. from S. E. at 4 P. M. to the West night to calm sail Middle moderate latter part same cloudy wind S. W. to N. W.

Sunday 16th Sept

Some part of these 24 hours thick rainy weather light winds from the South heading E. & E. at 4 P. M. took in sail Middle and latter part fine

Some part of these 24 hours fine weather at wind from S. E. heading S. E. Middle and latter parts light winds from the East

Wednesday 19th Sept

Some part fresh wind from the East heading S. E. at sundown took in sail strong winds heading to the daylight under double Reef wind from the East and rough Whales going quick to the West lowered but lost the

Lat 26 43 S Long 158 31 E

Thursday 20th Sept

Some part fresh wind from the East heading to the North Middle and latter strong winds heading

Lat 27 05 S Long 158 41

Friday 21st

Some part of these 24 hours fresh winds heading N. & N. W. saw the ship's jocos at night took in sail heading N. & N. W. Middle same latter strong winds from North

Lat 26 44 Long 157 50

Saturday 22nd Sept

Some part thick and rain wind heading N. & N. W. Middle part heading N. & E. by E latter parts up N. & N. W.

Lat by acct 26 45 Long 158 17

Sunday 23rd September

Some part of this day cleared off fine weather wind West heading to the South Middle light winds from N. & N. W. heading N. & N. W. latter parts same

Lat 27 03 S Long 158 30 E

Monday 24 Sept

Some part light winds from W. & W. heading to the North Middle and latter overcast light winds the W. & W. heading to the North
