Adelaide did not get fast saw them for a long way
Middle and latter parts fresh wind South heading to the

from the South at 3 P.M. saw Lord Howe Island & Perry E & S
sundown bore at E & S South Reef Middle and latter
parts equally at 10 A.M. went ashore and lay off & on
till Tuesday got off potatoes and beer
Obs. 159 31 about 28 miles to far East
