tending to the South and not going to the East and South East
Boat at 9 took him alongside fine weather at noon at 10

Thursday 31st Jan 1850
Some part squally wind East fresh
winds at 2 finished took in sail at sundown took ship to
at 8 E made and better part strong wind and rough sea
Boat sail Boiling Lat 32 36 Long 174 55

Friday 1st February 1850
Some part of this day strong East wind
Lead 60 fms. under short sail Boiling much same but
part some ship to the S E Lat 32 08 S Long 174 30

Saturday 2^d February
Some part more moderate finished
Boiling much and better part heading to the S E strong
winds Lat 32 48 Long 174 26

Sunday 3^d
Some part same heading S E by E
much part same better part west S E
Lat 32 17 S Long 174 33

Monday 4th
Some part of this day wind S E by E
Lead 60 fms. spoke ship (Thos. Brothers Capt. Jimmy 1800) 550 fms. made specially better strong wind more ship
at 8 E 3 sail in sight, 1 bearing down 400 fms. Lat

W & S Some part this part heading S E much
and better part same heading S E 2 ship in sight

Wednesday 5th February 1850

Some part fine S M in sight 7 ship
at 8 wind S E heading S E made and better heading to the
at S M in sight and 1 more to the west

Sunday 10th Feb
Some part calm much and better
at about the same in sight Lat 32 20 Long 175 40

Monday 11th
Some part about calm much and
at the fine weather wind S E the S M made that Mitchell
and Brothers in sight Lat 32 50 S Long 176 00

Tuesday 12th
Some part fine weather more ship at 8
at 8 same at daylight wind from S E a gale and heavy
at 8 S E Lat 32 20 Long 175 40

Wednesday 13th
Bad on L Bow some part heavy gale S E heading S E
at 8 ship in sight thick and heavy took in fine sail much heavy
at 8 wind S E heading S E the heading S E better part same
at 8 ship in sight cleared up a better
