under Double Reef heavy weather Lat 31 52 Long 175 40

Monday 18th

From part fresh wind S S E spoke
London Jacket had got a 50 lb whale at 6 noon ship to the East
Mice part same bath leading S S E S at 1 P M in sight

From part strong wind South lead
S S E at sundown some to the S W 3 sail in sight Mice and
bath Mowat's lead S W Lat 31 59 Long 175 15

Wednesday 20th

From part fine light wind S S

Lat 32 07 S Long 175 50

Thursday 21

Lead to the East Mice and some part fine S M in company at night
bath fine leading S W and S S Lat 32 22 Long 175 04

Friday 22nd March 1850

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From part fine breeze from South leading
S S E at night took in sail leading S S Mice same bath from
the from W S W leading to the West

Saturday 23rd

From part strong gale at W leading
the S S Mice same noon ship bath same leading South
Bath 1 other ship in sight Lat 32 28 Long 175 16

Sunday 24th

From part strong gale took in sail
leading South wind W S W Mice Mowat's noon ship at W
begin S M and S in sight Lat 32 22 Long 175 02

Monday 25th

From part fine light wind W S W
4 noon ship to the South S M in sight Mice and bath
leading S W by S at 5 A M a gale from S W took in sail leading
S W S M in sight Lat 32 35 Long 175 46 E

Tuesday 26th

From part a heavy gale from South
leading to the West took in sail Mice Mowat's bath
and highest leading S W Lat 32 14 Long 175 07

Wednesday 27

From part light wind S S E leading
S W S M in sight Mice and bath part high
Lat 32 15 Long 175 19

Thursday 28th

From part nearly calm spoke S M
and bath calm Lat 32 14 Long 175 37

Friday 29th

From part calm Mowat's brown
at the East bath fresh gale leading South
took in S M and S Jacket S M and S
