 Saturday 23rd  
 From part fine wind S E Course  
 W by South made same latter wind North leading W by N  
 strong current North Lat 33 27 Long 152 46  
 Sunday 24th  
 From part fine wind S E & N E &  
 down W by S made part same latter wind in sight  
 leading in for the heads  
 Monday 25th Nov  
 Went in at anchor at 3 P M

 at sundown leading S made same latter fresh wind  
 11 46.05 Lat 34 28 Long 152 27 E  
 Monday 13th Jan  
 From part wind South leading E by S  
 at sundown a gale took in sail made moderate  
 the head sail to the East  
 Lat 34 50 Long 153 06

 From part fine light air made wind  
 E latter North west E by S Lat 34 59 S Long 154 55  
 Wednesday 15th  
 From part fine wind N Course E by S
