Remarks On Board Thursday 13th Feb
First part of these 24 hours fine weather moderate breezes from the West Course S. E. & at sundown took in sail Doubled Reefs the 1st sail. Middle part wind from the S. E. and S. E. steering by the wind latter part fresh breezes at daylight made all sail steering by the land to the S. E. & E.
