Remarks On Board Saturday 15th Nov 1845

First part of these 24 hours ready for sea wind ahead Middle part fine light wind from the South latter part fresh Breeze at 7 A.M. took our anchor and stood out to sea wind S S W standing to the E S E all sail set got the anchor on the Bow and hauled up 3 sail in sight

Remarks On Board Sunday 16th Nov

First part of these 24 hours strong Breeze from the S by W steering to the East at sundown wind S S E Double Reefed the Top Sails took in jib & Main Sail Middle part cloudy blowing on at daylight took in Fore & Main Top Sails latter part a gale from the S S E Cloud Reefed the Main & Top Sails

Remarks On Board Monday 17th Nov

First part of these 24 hours a gale from the S S E rose to Cloud Reefed Main & Top Sails and fore sail heading to the East Middle part some wind S E latter part Moderate set Reefed Top Sails

Remarks On Board Tuesday 18th Nov

First part of these 24 hours fresh Breeze from the S E and Cloudy under Reefed Top Sails standing on the Eastern Tack Middle part wind changed to the S E wore ship to the South latter part fine weather all sail set

Remarks On Board Wednesday 19th Nov

First part of these 24 hours fine weather Moderate Breeze from the S by E all sail set by the wind to the South at sundown Double Reefed the Top Sails and carried the rest Middle part hazy S E latter part winds wind N E & heading S E found a strong E W current here

Remarks On Board Thursday 20th Nov

First part of these 24 hours fresh Breeze from the S E & all sail set by the wind to the S E at 5 P.M. saw Blackfish however that could not strike at sundown took in Sail Middle and latter part fine weather at daylight made all sail

Remarks On Board Friday 21st Nov

First part of these 24 hours all sail set wind S E Course S E by E 1 sail in sight at sundown Double Reefed the Top Sails on our Course Middle part same latter part all sail set saw Hithers

Remarks On Board Saturday 22nd Nov

First part of these 24 hours strong Breeze from E & E under Double Reef by the wind S E Middle and latter part strong Breeze wind E & E by the wind to the East took in Main Sail

Remarks On Board Sunday 23rd Nov

First part of these 24 hours strong Breeze from E & E under Double Reef to the East at sundown took in Sail Cloud Reefed Main & Top Sails Middle part fresh Breeze latter part fresh Breeze took in Fore & Main Top Sails and Cloud Reefed the Main & Top Sails

Remarks On Board Monday 24th Nov 1845

First part of these 24 hours fresh Breeze from the North and rainy weather with thunder & lightning at sundown under Cloud the Main Top Sails and fore sail to the E & wind to the S W saw Blackfish Middle part wind changed to the West latter strong Breeze under Double Reefed Top Sails heading to the E & E

Long by Obs 160° 31' East

Lat by Obs 34° 00' South

Remarks On Board Tuesday 25th Nov

First part of this day strong Breeze from the S W under Double Reef Top Sails heading to the S W at sundown took in the jib Middle part wore ship to the S W wind N E & W at daylight Made all sail fine weather strong in sight

Remarks On Board Wednesday 26th Nov

First part fine weather all sail set heading S by E wind from the North at sundown took in Sail Middle part fine latter part light air and calm repairing Main Top Sail Rats had a squall from the S W with thunder lightning took in all sail

Remarks On Board Thursday 27th Nov

First part of these 24 hours strong Breeze from the South made all Double Reef heading to the Eastward at sundown took in Sail Middle strong Breeze and squally latter part fresh Breeze from the S E under Double Reef

Remarks On Board Friday 28th Nov

First part of these 24 hours fresh Breeze from the S S W and S E under Double Reef at 3 P.M. wore ship to the East at sundown took in Sail Middle part fine latter part same all sail set wind S S W heading to the S W

Remarks On Board Saturday 29th Nov

First part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather light wind from the South at sundown took in Sail heading to the East Middle part calm latter part calm and light air from the North saw Blackfish broad and got on

Remarks On Board Sunday 30th Nov

First part of the 24 hours fine fresh Breeze from the S all sail set wore ship to the N E & W at sundown took in Sail Middle part fresh Breeze took in the Fore Sail at daylight set Double Reef Top Sails wind from the N E at 9 A.M. changed to the South set Top Sails under S

Remarks On Board Monday 1st December

First part of these 24 hours strong wind from the South and rugged Course N by W at sundown took in Sail heading to the Eastward Middle part strong Breeze latter part all sail set under S at Blacksmithy

Remarks On Board Tuesday 2nd December

First part of these 24 hours fine weather all sail set spoke London Racket at sundown took in Sail Middle part calm latter part light air from the North heading to the West the London Racket in sight saw nothing remarkable
