Remarks On Board Monday 22 June 1846

From part of these 24 hours fine weather with light winds from the East & S. E. Course S. by W. at sundown took in Sail High Island Bore S. E. by E. & low Island Bore S. by E. distant 5 leagues Middle laying off latter all Sail set heading to the East & S. E. low Island distant 3 leagues Lat 17° 16' South

Remarks On Board 23<sup>rd</sup> June

From part of these 24 hours wind S. E. & S. heading to the East & S. E. all Sail set finished the fore Sail Middle parts wind the same latter parts tacking off and on beating to the Eastward employed in repairing jibs Lat 16° 40' S

Remarks On Board 24<sup>th</sup> June

From part of these 24 hours strong breezes from the East heading to the East & S. E. all Sail set Middle parts heading S. E. latter parts fine 1 Sail inshore repaired the fore Sail Long 17° 04' East Lat 15° 56' South

Remarks On Board 25<sup>th</sup> June

From part of this day light breezes from the S. E. & S. packed ship to the South all Sail set employed in repairing fore Top Mast staysail Middle parts flying on the S. E. back latter parts standing in finished the staysail Long 17° 27' East Lat 16° 32' S

Remarks On Board 26<sup>th</sup> June

From part of these 24 hours fine light air from the S. E. & S. all Sail set heading to the S. E. by E. 4 miles off shore the BR. Hoopled 750 lbs Penn 21 months out Middle parts heading S. E. by E. latter part tacked in fore light breeze Jan in sight Long 17° 33' East Lat 15° 57' S

Remarks On Board Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> June

From part of these 24 hours light Breezes from the S. E. & S. in sight employed in tacking Bunting Main Top Sail at sundown Island of Gear Bore S. by E. distant 9 leagues tacked off fore Middle parts spoke Schooner Alfred Capt. Davenport 10 months 200 lbs Penn all Sail set heading to the East Long 17° 54' East Lat 16° 19' East

Remarks On Board Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> June

From part of these 24 hours all Sail set fresh Breezes from the S. E. & S. heading to the East at 4 P. M. Gear Bore East distant 2 leagues Middle and latter parts the same fresh Breezes from the East Lat 16° 11'

Remarks On Board Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June

From part of these 24 hours Breezes from the East all Sail set heading to the East off and on the fore spoke Schooner Alfred Middle parts fine heading off latter Middle all Sail employed on the Main Top Sail Long 17° 40' East Lat 16° 02'

Remarks On Board Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> June

From part of this day fine breezes off and on at sundown took in Sail Middle and latter parts fresh Breezes under Double Reef Top Sails off on Air, repairing Main Top Sail

Remarks On Board Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July 1846

From part of these 24 hours breezes from the S. E. under Reefed Top Sails laying off on the Reef the Alfred in company Middle and latter parts fine tacking off and on

Remarks On Board Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July

From part of these 24 hours fine steering to the N. E. & W. at sundown off Gear spoke Ship Dove Brothers 1000 lbs Penn 25 months out Middle laying about latter steering off along the Reef to the West in company with the Alfred Lat 16° 22'

Remarks On Board Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July

From part of these 24 hours light breezes steering off along to the Reef to the West at sundown lay by the wind Middle parts same latter steering off to the S. W. in company with the Alfred under the reef

Remarks On Board Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July

From part of these 24 hours light wind steering to the S. W. at sundown finished the Main Top Sail and Bent it and the fore took in Sail Round Island Bore S. by E. 4 leagues distant Middle laying off latter all Sail set steering for Low Island Lat 16° 56' S

Remarks On Board Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> July

From part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather with light winds from the S. E. Middle parts calm latter fresh Breezes saw Humph. back spoke Ship Minerva Capt. Bedford 21 months out 700 lbs Penn 1700 lbs Lat 17° 00'

Remarks On Board Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July

From part of these 24 hours fresh Breezes from the S. E. in company with the Minerva and two Brothers at sundown took in Sail Middle parts mugged latter parts the same employed on the Rigging Lat 16° 56'

Remarks On Board Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> July

From part of these 24 hours strong winds off and on low Island at night took in Sail in company with the fore Middle parts fine latter parts all Sail set heading in for Low Island employed on the Rigging under the Reef heading S. E. by E. per Compass distant 7 miles Lat 17° 51' East No Ob

Remarks On Board Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July

From part of these 24 hours moderate Breezes all Sail set at sundown Double Reefed the Top Sails low Island Bore S. by E. distant 14 leagues Middle and latter parts fresh Breezes employed on the Rigging low Island distant 2 miles

Remarks On Board Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> July

From part of these 24 hours strong breezes from the S. E. & S. in company with the Minerva at sundown low Island Bore S. E. distant 2 miles Course South Middle parts under Double Reef Top Sails latter parts all Sail set course S. by E. employed on the Rigging and tacking down Long 17° 03' E Lat 16° 44'
