Double Reefed Top Sails heading to the W.S.W. at sundown took in Mizzen  
Mast and latter part fresh breezes from the S.E. by S heading S.W.  
Long 161° 04 East Lat 24° 27 S

Remarks On Board Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from the S.E. heading  
to the S.W. at sundown Double Reefed Top Sails Mizzen Mast  
rugged latter part same as on Humphreys Course W.S.W.  
Long 159° 06 East Lat 24° 54 S

Remarks On Board Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours strong breezes from the  
S.E. under Double Reefed Course W.S.W. at sundown took in Fore & Mizzen  
Top Sails Mizzen Mast by the wind to the South latter part under Double Reefed Top  
Sails Course West Long 157° 25 East Lat 25° 10 S

Remarks On Board Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours strong breezes from the S.E.  
under Reefed Top Sails Course W.S.W. at sundown took in Fore Mast Top Sails and  
luffed to the S.E. Mizzen Mast and Top Sails to the South latter part reefed Top Sails  
Course W.S.W. very rugged Long 157° 07 East Lat 24° 42 S

Remarks On Board Monday 17<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours fresh gales from S.E. and rugged  
Course W.S.W. at sundown took in Fore Mast Mizzen Mast heading S.E. Mizzen Mast  
Ship to the South at daylight rugged Double Reefed Top Sails and were Ship to the North  
1.15k in sight Long 156° 24 E Lat 24° 35 S

Remarks On Board Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours ranging by the wind to the S.W.  
under Short Sail at sundown were Ship to the South Mizzen Mast latter part rugged as  
usual set double Reefed Top Sails and were Ship to the North the 13k in sight  
Long 156° 53 East Lat 24° 00 S

Remarks On Board Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of this day strong breezes from S.E. and  
rugged at sundown took in Mizzen Mast and latter part rugged under Double Reefed  
Heading to the North Long 156° 38 East Lat 24° 29 S

Remarks On Board Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours strong wind from the S.E.  
under Double Reefed Top Sails at 3 P.M. took in Fore Mast Mizzen Top Sails at sundown  
were Ship to the East wind S.W. Mizzen Mast wind S.W. & latter part a heavy gale  
from the North under Double Reefed Main Top Sails from sail in  
Long by Chart 157° 14 East Lat by Chart 24° 45 S

Remarks On Board Friday 21<sup>st</sup> August  
Fore part of this day wind lashed to the West and moderate  
set the Iron Sail heading to the North a 13k in sight Mizzen Mast a gale latter  
part same wind S.W. & were Ship again to the North  
Long 157° 16 East Lat 24° 45 S

Fore part of this day strong gale from the W.S.W. heading to heading  
to the S.W. Mizzen Mast moderate latter part weather all sail set heading to the  
South Long 157° 13 East Lat 24° 26 S

Remarks On Board Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours fine weather all sail set  
at sundown spoke 13k Panel of Ribney and took in sail Mizzen Mast light wind from  
the S.W. latter part mod. calm Long 157° 02 East Lat 24° 29 S

Remarks On Board Monday 24<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of this day calm at sundown took in sail Mizzen  
Mast latter part light wind from the S.E. steering S.W. by W.  
Long 156° 50 E Lat 24° 29 S

Remarks On Board Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part light wind from the East steering to the West at  
sundown took in sail Mizzen Mast in company with the same latter part all sail  
set heading to the North Long 156° 44 East Lat 24° 55 S

Remarks On Board Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours fine weather heading to the  
North at sundown took in sail Mizzen Mast to the South Mizzen Mast and latter part  
fine light wind from the S.E. all sail set  
Long 156° 43 East Lat 23° 01 S

Remarks On Board Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours fine light wind from the S.E.  
all sail set at sundown Double Reefed Top Sails heading to the South Mizzen Mast  
light wind from the S.E. latter part same all sail set saw Blackfish and Finbacks  
Long 156° 41 East Lat 23° 14 S

Remarks On Board Friday 28<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours light wind from the Eastward  
at sundown took in sail heading to the South Mizzen Mast calm latter part all sail  
set light wind from the S.E. Long 156° 47 East Lat 23° 55 S

Remarks On Board Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours fine weather light breeze from  
the S.E. heading to the East at sundown took in Ship to the S.W. by W. wind S.E.  
Mizzen Mast light wind latter part moderate breeze from the S.E. all sail set  
Finbacks Long 156° 26 E Lat 23° 21 S

Remarks On Board Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> August  
Fore part of these 24 hours fine weather all sail set  
winds moderate from the East breeze S.E. at sundown Double Reefed Top Sails  
Mizzen Mast and latter part light wind from the S.W. by S course S by E  
Long 156° 36 East Lat 24° 53 S

Remarks On Board Monday 31<sup>st</sup> August  
Fore part of this day light wind from the S.E. course S.W. by S  
at sundown Double Reefed Top Sails Mizzen Mast heading to the West latter part all sail  
set heading to the S.W. South Long 155° 59 E Lat 26° 32 S
