Remarks On Board Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> September 1844  
Gave part of their 24 hours strong breeze from the North and very rugged under Double Reefed Top Sails heading to the West at 4 P M saw a School of Spinn Whales bowled 2 boats but could not strike us suggest to chase them came on Board and took in Sail Middle parts strong gales and rugged latter parts made Sail heading to the West S W and S E wind Landed to the S from ship to the West

Remarks On Board Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> Sept  
Gave part of their 24 hours strong breeze from the S E heading to the S W more ship to the East spoke the same of Sunday 500 Tons at sundown Moderate and Overcast took in Sail Middle parts same with some rain latter strong winds from the S E more ship to the South took in Sails a breeze S E

Remarks On Board Monday 21<sup>st</sup> Sept  
Gave part of their 24 hours strong S E wind and rugged sail the Top Sails South Reefed and first Studding were ship to the S E at sundown took in Sail Middle parts same latter parts strong breeze and suggest more ship to the South at 10 A.M. saw a School of Spinn Whales going quick to the Southward but could not come up with them

Remarks On Board Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> Sept  
Gave part of their 24 hours strong S E wind and rugged carrying sail to the East of Shore at sundown single Reefed the Top Sails heading to the S E Middle parts same latter parts strong breeze and suggest more ship to the South

Remarks On Board Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> Sept  
Gave part of their 24 hours strong breeze from the S E by E heading to the S E at 3 A.M. saw a School of Spinn Whales going very quick to the South made Sail at 5 hours for them but could not overtake them at sundown came on Board and took in Sail Middle and latter parts strong breeze and suggest more ship to the S W

Gave part of their 24 hours strong breeze from the S E by E and very rugged heading to the S W under Double Reefed at sundown took in Sail Middle parts strong breeze and suggest more ship to the South

Remarks On Board Friday 25<sup>th</sup> Sept  
Gave part of their 24 hours strong breeze from the North steering South at sundown took in Sail heading to the East Middle parts were ship to the Westward latter parts made Sail rugged with some rain at 11 A.M. saw a School of Spinn Whales

Remarks On Board Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> Sept  
Gave part of their 24 hours strong breeze from the North at 4 P M wind Landed to the Westward and to the South with rain thunder and lightning took in Sail heading to the S W Middle parts Moderate over latter parts fine weather made all Sail few whale passed and struck the Laidboard Boat at 10 A.M. took him alongside and began to cut him S E

Remarks On Board Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> Sept  
Gave part of their 24 hours strong breeze from the North at 4 P M wind Landed to the Westward and to the South with rain thunder and lightning took in Sail heading to the S W Middle parts Moderate over latter parts fine weather made all Sail few whale passed and struck the Laidboard Boat at 10 A.M. took him alongside and began to cut him S E
