From Pacific Ocean Towards United States
Remarks On Board Monday 22nd March 1847
Fore part of these 24 hours strong Breezes from the N with plenty
of rain under Single Reefed Top Sails and Courses at sundown squally Double Reefed the Top
Sails Course ESE Middle part rain took in Main Sail strong gale and squally
latter part set the Main Sails and job strong gale took in job raiing thick and raiing
Long by Obs 175° 14' West Lat by Obs 38° 44'

Remarks On Board Tuesday 23rd March
Fore part of these 24 hours strong gale from the N with much
the Main sail Course E by E at sundown Close Reefed from Top Sail took in Mizzen Top Sail
sprung the yard Middle part raiing and squally latter part same
Long by Obs 170° 39' West Lat by Obs 40° 00'

Remarks On Board Wednesday 24th March
Fore part of these 24 hours wind from the N W and light made
all sail Course E fine weather Middle and fore part light winds and clear sail down
Mizzen Top Sail yard and fishes it
Long by Obs 169° 22' West Lat by Obs 40° 39'

Remarks On Board Thursday 25th March
Fore part of these 24 hours light wind from the West Course
East sent up Mizzen Top Sail yard and set the sail and set up new Reefed the Top
Sails Middle and latter part no alterations in the wind or weather
Long by Obs 167° 41' West Lat by Obs 40° 06'

Remarks On Board Friday 26th March
Fore part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather all sail set
light winds from the West Course East Middle part same latter part fine weather strong
sails set
Long by Obs 166° 17' East Lat by Obs 41° 06'

Remarks On Board Saturday 27th March
Fore part of these 24 hours light Breezes from the West Course
East sent all Top Mast altering Sail N S & steering sail & beat Mizzen by Sallant Sail
and Top job Middle part light air latter part same wind from the North
Long by Obs 164° 55' West Lat by Obs 41° 20'

Remarks On Board Sunday 28th March
Fore part of these 24 hours light air from the N E all sail
set leading by the wind ESE Middle part leading SSE latter part fresh Breeze
from the East took in 2nd Mizzen Top Sail and Top job and hooked the Top to the West &
Long by Obs 164° 17' West Lat by Obs 42° 00'

Remarks On Board Monday 29th March
Fore part of these 24 hours light Breezes from the East
leading on the North took at 3 P.M. took in N S & Sail being squally with
some rain Middle part same latter part strong breeze under Top Sails & Course leading
ESE and ESE by E employed at various jobs about the Ship
Long by Obs 163° 37' West Lat by Obs 40° 36'
