Fore part of these 24 hours fresh Breezes from the S & E leading N & E under 1/2 Sail and Courses at 4 1/2 M. set the main & 1/2 Sail Middle and latter parts light breezes from the S & E more Ship to the S & E.

Fore part of these 24 hours fresh Breezes from the North Course East all Sail set but before Steering Sail and set it wind from the S & E. Middle parts wind hauled to the S & E took in Steering Sails, latter parts rain, with fresh breeze

Fore part of these 24 hours fresh Breezes from S & E and rain, Reading East middle parts wind from the S & E set the Steering Sails, latter parts calm fine pleasant weather

Fore part of these 24 hours strong gales from the S & E all Sails up the 4th Sail and set the Courses heading S & E Middle parts strong gales took in main Sail latter parts same

Remarks On Board Wednesday 14th April

Fore part of these 24 hours strong gales from the East heading to the South under close Reefed 1/2 main & 1/2 Sails and fore Sail at sundown were Ship to the S & E Middle parts moderate latter parts set Double Reefed 1/2 Sails and Courses and jib heading S & E
