Fore part of these 24 hours strong winds from the S E by S and ragged rain Double Reefed Top Sails and Courses heading E by S Middle and latter part light air and cloudy all sail set heading E by S

Fore part of these 24 hours calm at 6 P M light air from the S E and cloudy heading E by S all sail set Middle and latter part fresh Breezes took in 2nd Mizzen Top Gallant Sails Reading E by S

Remarks On Board Saturday 17th April

Fore part of these 24 hours strong breezes took in E by S and South Reefed the Top Sails wind E by S heading E by S Middle part fairer latter part blew the Top Sails & Course at 10 A M wind fell off light

Remarks On Board Sunday 18th April

Fore part of these 24 hours calm with light rain Middle part strong calms from the S E & S then blew Top Sails and Reefed Courses, Course E by S latter part a Gale

Fore part of these 24 hours a Gale from the S E & S under Close Reefed Top Sails and Reefed Courses Course E by S at sundown more moderate turned with the wind out of the fore Course and one set Main Top Sail Middle part set the Top Sails and Courses latter part fine breeze from the S W all sail set Course East

Fore part of these 24 hours fine moderate breeze from the West all sail set Course East Middle part fresh breeze from S E & S top in Top Sails latter part fine weather wind South all sail set

Fore part of these 24 hours light winds from the S E & S all sail set On the wind to the East Middle part fresh breeze from S E & S heading E by S latter part tacked to the South with weather

Remarks On Board Saturday 24th April

Fore part of these 24 hours moderate wind E by S heading S E by S under Double Reefed Top Sails and Courses Middle and latter part no alterations

Fore part of these 24 hours more ship to the S E & S fresh breeze from the East Middle part heading E by S latter part wind veered to the S E and more moderate made sail heading E by S

Fore part of these 24 hours moderate breezes from S E heading E by S all sail set Middle part wind South Course East latter part wind to the South West set S. S. M. Steering Sails fresh foggy weather

Fore part of these 24 hours good breeze from S W all sail set Course East cloudy weather Middle part fresh gales took in Main Top Sails & Double Reefed the Top Sails at 4 P M took on Main Sail from the yard latter part wind South with heavy squalls of hail & snow sent the Main Sail up and reefed it

Fore part of these 24 hours moderate breeze from the West under South Reefed 2nd Main Top Sails and Courses wind South Course East Middle part wind unsteady during squalls latter part strong squalls of hail & snow heading E by S

Remarks On Board Thursday 29th April

Fore part of these 24 hours strong squalls from the S E under Double Reefed Sails and Courses heading E by S Middle part wind veered to the South and moderate heading E by S latter part moderate wind S W all sail set Course E by S

Remarks On Board Friday 30th April

Fore part of these 24 hours fresh breeze from the West all sail set Course E by S at 1 P M took on Main Top Mast & Main Top Sails Middle part fresh breeze from the West took in the steering Sails latter part fresh gales and foggy weather and overcast
