Fore part of these 24 hours moderate breezes from the N.W. course
E by S all sail set middle parts breeze east latter part more moderate wind West and cloudy

Fore part of these 24 hours moderate breezes from the West all

Remarks On Board Wednesday 5th May
Fore part of these 24 hours fresh sails and thick weather from
the N.W. at 4 P.M. wind fell off and veered to the S.W. the breeze Reefed the Top Sails and
courses middle parts all which courses thick and snow latter part clear strong
breezes from the N.W. made sail and took in again wind freshened
Long by Chron. 87° 51' West Lat by Obs 54° 10' S

Remarks On Board Thursday 6th May
Fore part of these 24 hours fresh sails and heavy squalls
from the N.W. at 11 A.M. under Double Reefed the Top Sails and courses took in at 3 P.M.
Course E by N at 4 P.M. wind veered to the N.W. middle parts West and fine pleasant
weather with moderate wind latter part fresh breezes from the N.W.
Long by Chron. 83° 34' West Lat by Obs 54° 49' S

Remarks On Board Friday 7th May
Fore part of these 24 hours fresh sails from the N.W. and small
clouds Reefed the Top Sails at 3 P.M. wind veered to the West set Double Reefed Top Sails
middle parts heavy squalls from the West latter part same
Long by Chron. 79° 14' West Lat by Obs 55° 41' S

Fore part of these 24 hours a gale from the West with
heavy squalls under Double Reefed Top Sails and fore courses course E by N
middle and latter parts fine weather all sail set light winds from the

Remarks On Board Tuesday 11th May
Fore part of these 24 hours fresh sails from the West
and squally under short sail course E by N middle parts heavy squalls of hail latter
part squalls of hail & snow all sail set course E by N

Remarks On Board Wednesday 12th May
Fore part of these 24 hours moderate breezes from the N.W.
all sail set course E by N at sundown squalls of hail Reefed the Top Sails and main
sail middle parts wind from the S.W. made sail latter part all sail set and up steering sail
hooms and set to S mast and N.W. steering sails saw a Brig steering E by N
Long by Chron. 59° 40' West Lat by Obs 58° 54' S

Fore part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from the N.W. all
course N.W. at sundown squally Double Reefed the Top Sails middle parts fine weather
latter part same all anchoring sail set with fresh breezes from the N.W.
Long by Chron. 56° 26' West Lat by Obs 59° 41' S

Fore part of these 24 hours fresh breezes from the N.W. all sail
set course E by N middle parts light wind latter part same but the steering sails and put up
main Royal all sail set

the N.W. all sail set course E by N a brig in sight middle parts light wind from the S.W. and
