Remarks On Board Monday 17th May 1847

Fore part of these 24 hours fresh S.W. breeze from the S.W. all sail set course S.W. by E. Middle part wind veered to the North but in steering sails heading S.W. latter part wind veered to the S.W. by E. course S.W. by E.
Long by Alt 53° 50' West Lat by Alt 49° 50' S

Remarks On Board Tuesday 18th May

Fore part of these 24 hours thick and foggy weather under short sail light wind from the S.W. by E. heading S.W. by E. at 10 A.M. closed reefed the courses Middle part fine weather light wind from the West made shift course S.W. by E. latter part wind veered to the S.W. and a gale came on took in sail closed reefed Main Top Sail and set the spinnaker heading S.W. by E.
Long by Alt 51° 51' 55" West Lat by Alt 48° 45' S

Remarks On Board Wednesday 19th May

Fore part of this day a S.W. breeze from the S.W. by E. reefed the Main Top Sail and closed reefed the S.W. by E. sail and set the Main Top Sail under short sail heading to the S.W. by E. latter part S.W. and squally.
Long by Alt 50° 40' West Lat 49° 00'

Remarks On Board Thursday 20th May

Fore part of these 24 hours heavy squally from the West soon veered to the S.W. the again under short sail heading to the East at 10 A.M. made shift to the West Middle and latter part fresh S.W. and heavy squally from S.W. by E. to S.W. by E. heading on both tacks
Long by Alt 51° 14' West Lat by Alt 48° 20'

Remarks On Board Friday 21st May

Fore part of these 24 hours fresh S.W. and heavy squally from S.W. by E. to S.W. by E. under short sail heading on each tack Middle part moderate set the S.W. sail latter part light squally made shift heading S.W. by E. to S.W. by E.
Long by Alt 49° 47' West Lat by Alt 47° 55'

Remarks On Board Saturday 22nd May

Fore part of these 24 hours fine weather with light squally from the S.W. by E. all sail set heading to the S.W. by E. at 10 A.M. doubled reefed the S.W. sail Middle and latter part light wind and calm with some squally heading from S.W. by E. to S.W. by E.
Long by Alt 48° 43' 27" West Lat by Alt 47° 16'

Remarks On Board Sunday 23rd May

Fore part cloudy light wind from the West all sail set course S.W. by E. Middle part wind veered from West to S.W. and squally under single reefed Top Sail latter part veered to the South all sail set with steering sails
Long by Alt 47° 20' West Lat 46° 12'

Remarks On Board Monday 24th May

Fore part of this day fresh S.W. breeze from the S.W. all sail set course S.W. by E. Middle part fresh breeze latter part moderate all the steering sails set wind S.W. by E.
Long by Alt 46° 02' West Lat by Alt 44° 10'

Remarks On Board Tuesday 25th May 1847

Fore part of these 24 hours fine weather light wind from the S.W. all sail set course S.W. by E. Middle part wind veered to the North but in steering sails heading S.W. by E. latter part wind veered to the S.W. by E. course S.W. by E.
Long by Alt 45° 05' West Lat by Alt 43° 00' South

Remarks On Board Wednesday 26th May

Fore part of these 24 hours moderate breeze from the S.W. with fine weather all sail set heading S.W. by E. Middle and latter part strong wind from the S.W. by E. heading S.W. by E. latter part took in Main Top Sail and Top Sail.
Long by Alt 43° 05' West Lat by Alt 41° 15' S

Remarks On Board Thursday 27th May

Fore part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the S.W. by E. heading S.W. by E. under single reefed Top Sail & courses Middle part light wind the Top Sails latter part fresh S.W. and squally took in Main Top Sail and closed reefed the Top Sails.
Long by Alt 41° 00' West Lat by Alt 40° 10' S

Remarks On Board Friday 28th May

Fore part of these 24 hours fresh S.W. breeze from the S.W. by E. and squally reefed the S.W. sail and took in S.W. Top Sail heading to the S.W. by E. under closed reefed Main Top Sail and reefed S.W. sail and Main Top Sail at 10 P.M. wind veered to the South course S.W. by E. latter part cloudy with moderate breeze all sail on
Long by Alt 39° 04' West Lat by Alt 39° 10' S

Remarks On Board Saturday 29th May

Fore part of these 24 hours moderate breeze from the South all sail set course S.W. by E. Middle part light air latter part fine with light air and veered to the S.W. took out one cloth in the fore Royal and buntline
Long by Alt 38° 21' West Lat by Alt 37° 35' S

Remarks On Board Sunday 30th May

Fore part of these 24 hours fine clear weather wind light from the S.W. by E. tacked ship to the East all sail set Middle part wind veered to the West course S.W. by E. all sail set
Long by Alt 37° 39' West Lat by Alt 37° 15' S

Remarks On Board Monday 31st May

Fore part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather light breeze from the S.W. to West all sail set course S.W. by E. Middle and latter part same fine weather employed at ship's duty
Long by Alt 37° 08' West Lat by Alt 36° 43'

Remarks On Board Tuesday 1st June

Fore part of these 24 hours fine pleasant weather light air from the S.W. by E. all sail set heading S.W. by E. Middle and latter part fine weather moderate breeze from the S.W. by E. by the wind to the S.W. by E.
Long by Alt 35° 49' West Lat by Alt 35° 23'
