Sea of warren now lying at the port of Lushan
on the Island of Chow all of this day employed at paint
ing ship and breasting out the after hatch Mr Green
officer of was discharged likewise Mr Groves &
officers

Tuesday 22 This day employed at a little of bre
thing stowed off the after hull with keel and done so
particulars lashed on the windlass beams and received
18 barrels of potatoes and 8 kegs of white lead

Wednesday 23 fairly of work sent a raft of cast
in shore to fill water received 104 barrels of sweet
potatoes one boat anchor 2 boxes of Asses meat and a
one barrel of split peas 2 ships came to anchor one
the hero of Antioch the other unknown
and saw another in the passage at sundown
Spencer one of our crew boat steers came on board
Expected more of them but they did not come

Thursday 24 all of this day pleasant weather but
had a heavy swell setting in from the N.E.
So that we could get with water off employed
at mending fly jibbe and setting up the shunter top
most backstays latter part of the day the bottom
bars came to anchor I went on board found them
all well but at great deal of dissatisfaction
She has taken 14 hundred barrels of oil this
season
