

Remarks on board Bark Columbus of New Bedford

Wednesday June 10th these 24 hours commenced with light winds from the NW steering to the SSE Middle part rainy latter part ~~rainy~~ calm commenced backing Blackfish
Lat 55.59 Long 42.40

Thursday June 11th commenced with calm weather sailing Blackfish which met 3 1/2 lbs oil Middle part light winds from the W with rain latter part strong breezes from SW to W steering to the E. heavy squalls with rain
Lat 36.03 Long 48.50 so ends the 24 hours

Friday June 12th commenced with strong breezes from the SW with rain 3 sail in sight shortened sail steering to the eastward Middle part the same latter part frequent squalls of rain with a heavy swell on
Lat 36.40 Long 42.24

Saturday June 13th commenced with strong breezes from the W with a heavy sea and 5 sail in sight steering to the E Middle and latter part the same
Lat 37.20 Long 41.10 setting up rigging

Sunday June 14th commenced with strong breezes from the SW steering to the E by S 1 brig in sight heading to the north thick weather Middle part strong gales from the SW with rain have the ship to under short sail latter part moderates steering SSE lat 38.00 Long 38.01

Monday June 15 commenced with strong breezes from the SW steering SSE saw finbacks Middle and latter part the same 1 sail in sight Lat 37.58 Long 35.37

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Tuesday June 15th

Commenced with strong breezes from the SW heading ENE heavy weather heavy swell on Middle part the same latter part rain sent down main top galleen sail to let the head off Lat 39.12 Long 33.37 so ends the 24 hours

Wednesday June 16th

Commenced with light breezes from the NE heading from E by S to SSE sent the top galleen sail up Middle part the same latter part wind from the NW steering SE
Lat 40.15 N Long 32.40

Thursday June 17th

Commenced with light winds from the NW steering SSE 1 sail in sight Middle and latter part the same Lat 39.49 Long 30.35

Friday June 18th

Commenced with light winds from the SW steering SE flower bearing SW distance 45 miles Middle part shortened heading SSE latter part St George bearing SSE distance 12 miles Lat 38.31 Long 27.50

Saturday June 19th

Commenced with light winds from the W saw nothing St George distance 1 mile Middle and latter part the same Lat 38.25 Long 27.40

Sunday June 20th

Commenced with light winds from the SE Land in sight Middle part the same latter part light winds from ENE Perava bearing SW distance 10 miles

Monday June 21st

Commenced with strong winds from the ENE Land in sight Middle and latter part the same Lynx bearing SW distance 14 miles
