

6 Remarks on Board Bark Columbus of New Bedford

Tuesday June 23rd

Commenced with strong breezes from the E & heading to the S 1 sail in sight saw fin. Back Middle and Latter part Light winds from the E got some fish of Tunny

Wednesday June 24th

Commenced with Light breezes from the E standing in for the Land 1 sail in sight Middle part Calm Latter part light winds from the South

Thursday June 25th

Commenced with Light winds from the S Middle part the same Latter part of Gracee in company with ship Minerva of New Bedford

Friday June 26th

Commenced with calm weather of Gracee tracking for potatoes and onions 1 Bark in sight Middle and Latter part the same spoke Bark Whitwood of New Bedford so ends

Saturday June 27th

These 24 hours commenced with Light winds from the eastward of Gracee steering to the westward 3 sail in sight Middle and Latter part the same so ends these 24 hours

Sunday June 28th

Commenced with Light winds from the E to N.E. steering to the westward Land in sight Middle and Latter part Calm so ends

Monday June 29th

Commenced with calm weather spoke Bark City Embark of London in state of anxiety crew took the ship and put in to Fayal for protection Middle and Latter part the same Latter part Light winds from the S.W. so ends

Tuesday June 30th

Commenced with strong breezes from the North Fayal being 9.58 distance 12 miles Middle part the same of Fayal Latter part spoke ship Henry of Connecticut and got Letters and sent some on shore with 2 men

Wednesday July 1 1820

Commenced with Light winds from the N got potatoes onions &c put a way in company with ship Henry got 2 men Middle and Latter part wind from N.W. steering from S.W. by S to S.W. Lat 37.51 Long 28.6

Thursday July 2nd

Commenced with pleasant breezes from the N steering S.W. 3 sail in sight steaming whole watches Middle and Latter part the same with ship Henry of Connecticut Lat 35.16 Long 27.40

Friday July 3rd

Commenced with Light winds from the N steering S.W. Middle and Latter part Calm Lat 34.30 Long 27.38

Saturday July 4th

Commenced with Light winds from the S.E. 1 sail in sight Middle and Latter part Calm Lat 34.20 Long 27.10

Sunday July 5th

Commenced with calm weather Middle part the same Latter part Light winds from the N.E. steering S.W. Lat 33.37 Long 26.27

Monday July 6th

Commenced with strong breezes from the N.E. steering S.W. 1 sail in sight Middle and Latter part the same steering from S.W. to S by E Lat 31.15 Long 26.54
