Tuesday July 7th

these 24 hours commenced with strong breezes from the N.E. steering from S by W to S by E in company with ship Henry of Nantucket Middle and latter part the same
Lat 27.54 Long 26.26

Wednesday July 8th
Commenced with strong breezes from the E heading S by W heavy sea on Middle and latter part the same
Lat 25.16

Thursday July 9th
Commenced with strong breezes from the E steering S by W gamming with ship Henry of Nantucket Middle and latter part steering E heavy sea on
Lat 22.22 Long 25.42 W

Friday July 10th
Commenced with strong breezes from the N.E. steering S nothing in sight Middle and latter part the same Lat 19.50 Long 24.00

Saturday July 11th
these 24 hours commenced with strong breezes from the N.E. steering S heavy sea on Middle and latter part the same of St. Nicholas Lat 13.11 Long 24.07

Sunday July 12th
Commenced with light breezes from the N.E. steering S by W St. Nicholas 12 miles dist Middle and latter part ^{the same} but 1 man on shore got bag and fruit sent letters home of St. Jap

Monday July 13th
Commenced with light breezes from the N.E. of St. Jap 5 sail in sight Middle and latter part steering E wind light
Lat 13.52 Long 22.54 W

Tuesday July 14th 1840

Commenced with light winds from the N.E. heading South Middle and latter part steering S by W Lat 12.05 Long 22.50

Wednesday July 15th
Commenced with light winds from the N.W. steering S by W in place looking out and steering of Middle and latter part the same
Lat 10.32

Thursday July 16th
Commenced with light winds from the N.E. steering S steering down Middle and latter part calm with rain so ends

Friday July 17th
Commenced with calm with rain 2 sail in sight Middle and latter part strong breezes from the S by W heading from S.E. to S.S.E. sail in sight Lat 08.36 Long 22.05

Saturday July 18th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.S.W. steering S.E. Middle and latter part wind from W and S.W. steering from S to S.S.E. so ends
Lat 07.15 Long 18.55

Sunday July 19th
Commenced with strong breezes from S.W. heading to the S.S.E. 1 sail in sight Middle and latter part the same tacked ship heading to the W Lat 06.48

Monday July 20th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.E. heading to the W Middle and latter part the same Lat 5.22 4 miles

Tuesday July 21th
strong breezes from the S.E. heading to W S.W. Bank of thalys to windward 5 sail in sight Middle and latter part moderate breezes from S.E. heading S.W. Lat 3.58 Long 20.54
