Commenced with strong trades steering by the wind Middle and Latter part the same. Saw Black fish Lat 7.54 S Long 83.04 W

Tuesday Dec 1st

Moderate trades leading. I W lowered for Black fish did not get any. Middle and Latter part the same Lat 7.57 S Long 84.57 W

Wednesday Dec 2nd

Moderate trade winds steering by the wind Middle and Latter part the same Lat 7.49 S Long 84.01 W

Thursday Dec 3rd

Moderate trades steering. I W by 8 saw Black fish Middle and Latter part the same Lat 6.52 S Long 82.38 W

Friday Dec 4th

Fresh trades steering. I W Middle and Latter part the same Land in sight Lat 6.01 Long 84.33 West

Saturday Dec 5th

Fresh trades steering. I W by 8 of Riffs Middle and Latter part steering. I W for Tumbay Lat 5.57 S Long 81.17

Sunday Dec 6th

Moderate trades steering down the coast for Tumbay at 9 P.M. anchored of Tumbay with 1 English Bark

Monday Dec 7th

This day at Tumbay with 3 ships getting wood and water

Tuesday Dec 8th

Laying of Tumbay getting wood and water

Wednesday Dec 9th

Laying of Tumbay getting water and baking out

Thursday Dec 10th

Fine weather of Tumbay getting wood &c

Friday Dec 11th

Laying of Tumbay watch an Liberty

Tuesday Dec 15th 1840

Commenced with light winds from the N at 6 A.M. took the anchor and went to sea middle and Latter part strong breezes steering by the wind with the Kingstone

Wednesday Dec 16th

Strong trades steering by the wind to the Westward Middle and Latter part the same in company with Ship Kingstone of Dartmouth Lat 3.06 S Long 84.50 W

Thursday Dec 17th

Strong trades steering W Middle and Latter part the same Lat 2.32 S Long 84.34 W

Friday Dec 18th

Fresh trade winds leading W by W Middle and Latter part the same Lat 2.22 S Long 86.26 West to Ends

Saturday Dec 19th

Moderate trade winds steering W by S Middle and Latter part the same Lat 2.11 S Long 86.51 W

Sunday Dec 20th

Moderate trades steering W by S mending main to galleen sail Middle and Latter part the same Charles Island in sight Lat 1.57 S Long 90.02 W

Monday Dec 21st

Moderate trades sails Island bearing N by 15 miles sail is right Middle and Latter part the same Lat 1.11 S

Tuesday Dec 22nd

Strong trades steering W by N allernmark in sight jamming with ships American and Kingstone of Dartmouth Middle and Latter part the same Lat 0.32 S

Wednesday Dec 23rd

Light trades jamming with ships Kingstone and American Middle and Latter part the same of allernmark

Thursday Dec 24

Light trades winds of winds over Middle and Latter part of allernmark went a shore for terapin did not get any

Friday Dec 25

Strong trades of Rodolfo Bark got some fish Middle and Latter part steering W by W Lat 0.02 S Long 93.44 W
