Wednesday March 31st 1841

Strong trades by the wind Middle and latter part the same Lat 44° S Long 134° 49' W

Thursday April 1st

Strong trades by the wind Middle and latter part the same Lat 45° S Long 130° 14' W

Friday April 2nd

Moderate trades steaming, it by E Middle and latter part the same raining so ends

Saturday April 3rd

Strong trade winds steaming, it by E Middle and latter part the same Lat 41° S Long 130° 23' W

Sunday April 4th

Moderate trades by the wind latter part steaming of E by it Lat 40° S

Monday April 5th

Moderate trade winds steaming, it by E Middle and latter part it Lat 41° S

Tuesday April 6th

Moderate trades and raining steaming of Middle and latter the same so ends

Wednesday April 7th

Moderate trades and raining Middle and latter part the same Lat 39° S Long 131° 19' W

Thursday April 8th

Strong trade winds steaming, I saw 2 seals to windward so ends Lat 31° S Long 131° 48' W

Friday April 9th

Moderate trade winds steaming, it latter part the same Lat 20° S

Saturday April 10th

Moderate trades steaming, it by W Middle and latter part the same Lat 13° S

Sunday April 11th



Moderate trade winds steaming, it by W Middle to the yards, saw sperm whales several and took 1 latter part saw more several and got 1 Lat 17° S Long 132° 31' W

Monday April 12th 1841



Moderate trades backing by the wind saw sperm whales going to windward quick Middle and latter part the same Lat 38° S Long 132° 30' W

Tuesday April 13th

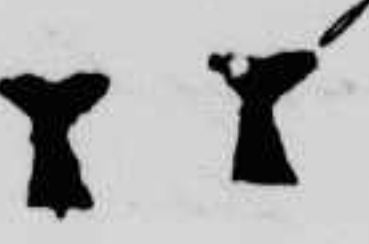
Moderate trade winds backing Middle and latter part the same Lat 32° S Long 132° 30'

Wednesday April 14th



Moderate trades backed down spoke ship Vineyards of Experiment got latter Middle and latter part the same saw sperm whales several and based 3 hours did not get any

Thursday April 15th



Moderate trade winds by the wind Middle and latter part the same saw 9 whales found to windward several did not get any Lat 30° S Long 132° 01' W

Friday April 16th

Strong trade winds by the wind Middle and latter part the same Lat 28° S Long 132° 15' W

Saturday April 17th

Moderate trade winds steaming by the wind latter part the same steaming down to air Lat 27° S so ends

Sunday April 18th

Moderate trade winds by the wind Middle and latter part the same Lat 25° S Long 132° 21' W

Monday April 19th

Moderate trades by the wind Middle and latter part the same Lat 17° S

Tuesday April 20th



Moderate trades saw 9 whales several struck and saved a cow and calf and took them to the ship latter part but then too backing Lat 15° S Long 132° 30' W

Wednesday April 21st

Moderate trades backing latter backed down so ends Lat 49° S
