Thursday May 13th 1841

Moderate trade winds by the wind commenced hoisting sails away the heads Middle and latter part the same sail in sight Lat 10° S Long 133.31 W

Friday May 14th

Moderate trade winds hoisting Middle and latter part the same Lat 10° S Long 132.31 W

Saturday May 15th

Moderate trade winds by the wind Middle and latter part the same Lat 11° S

Sunday May 16th



Moderate trade winds by the wind saw Whales lower struck and parted from 1 Middle and latter part the same Lat 10° S

Monday May 17

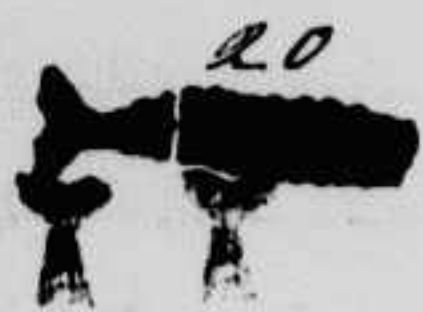


Moderate trade winds saw Whales lower struck and parted from 1 large Whale struck and saw 2 saw Whales stove 1 boat and hunt for Fishes picked up the boat took the Whales to the ship latter part cut them in Lat 8° N Long 132.21 W

Tuesday May 18th

Moderate trade winds hoisting ship the wind ceases Lat 5° S

Wednesday May 19



Moderate trade winds by the wind Middle and latter part saw Whales lower struck and saw 1 struck and took the line struck 1 large Whale and stove the boat and cut from him

Thursday May 20

Moderate trade winds by the wind Middle and latter part hoisting

Friday May 21

Strong trade winds hoisting latter part hoisted down Lat 3° N Long 131.51 W

Saturday May 22nd 1841

Strong trade winds hoisting Middle and latter part the same hoisting down Lat 14° S

Sunday May 23rd

Moderate trade winds by the wind Middle and latter part strong breeze Lat 1° N Long 132.27

Monday May 24th

Strong trade winds by the wind Middle and latter part hoisting out for books and water Lat 2° N

Tuesday May 25th



Strong trade winds by the wind latter part saw Whales lower got 1 stove the boat Lat 4° S

Wednesday May 26



Strong trade winds by the wind saw Whales lower struck and saved 1 took him to the ship latter part cut him in and commenced hoisting

Thursday May 27

Latter

Moderate trade winds hoisting spoke ship 6 cables broad of 11 Buckets latter part hoisted down Lat 6° S 132.21 W

Friday May 28

Moderate trade winds by the wind Middle and latter part the same Lat 19° S Long 132.44 W

Saturday May 29th

Moderate trade winds by the wind latter part hoisted of the main back Lat 23° S Long 132.49 W

Sunday May 30th

Moderate trade winds by the wind 1 sail in sight Middle and latter part the same Lat 30° S Long 132.50 W

Monday May 31

Moderate trade winds and no fish Middle and latter part the same Lat 30° S Long 132.35 W

Tuesday June 1st 1841

Moderate trade winds by the wind Middle and latter part the same hoisting with Ships 6 broad and 10 Buckets Lat 19° S
