Thursday April 21, 1842

Moderate trades steering S by W middle and latter part the same lat 28° 4' long 126° 02' W

Friday April 22

Moderate trades steering S by W middle and latter part the same lat 28° 4' long 125° 58' W

Saturday April 23

Moderate trade winds steering S by W middle and latter part the same 1 mile in sight lat 28° 9' long 125° 10' W

Sunday April 24

Moderate trades steering W by W middle and latter part the same lat 28° 1' long 124° 58' W

Monday April 25

Moderate trades steering S by W middle and latter part the same lat 28° 1' long 124° 58' W

Tuesday April 26



Moderate trades steering S by W saw 2 whales lowerd struck 3 and saved 2 took them to the ship and put them in scows lat 28° 9'

Wednesday April 27

Moderate trades backing steering S latter part South lat 28° 1' long 124° 09' W

Thursday April 28

Moderate trades steering S finessed backing so ends lat 27° 1' long 123° 08' W

Friday April 29

Moderate trades steering S 1/2 mile in sight middle and latter part the same lat 27° 3' long 122° 18' W

Saturday April 30

Moderate trades steering S by W middle and latter part the same lat 27° 3' long 121° 08' W

Sunday May 1 1842



Moderate trades steering S 1/2 mile in sight saw 2 whales lowerd but not get any near 28° 9'

Monday May 2

Moderate trades by the wind saw whale lowerd struck a baby whale and stove the boat did not get him took the boat to the ship so ends lat 28° 1' long

Tuesday May 3 1842



Strong trades steering S saw 2 whales lowerd struck 1 and took the line last the whale

so ends

Wednesday May 4

Strong trades spoke ship at anchor of St. James got letters 40 long lat 28° 1' long 125° 30'

Thursday May 5

Strong trades steering middle and latter part the same lat 35° S

Friday May 6



Strong trades saw 2 whales lowerd struck and got 1 took him to the ship middle part rounded off latter part let him in lat 28° 9' long 124° 29'

Saturday May 7

Moderate trades by the wind sailing spoke ship crushed net of St. James finished 30 long middle and latter part Strong breeze lat 28° 9' long 123° 16' W

Sunday May 8

Stronger trade winds by the wind middle and latter part the same 3 mile in sight lat 28° 9' long 122° 10' W

Monday May 9

Moderate trade winds by the wind middle and latter part the same latter part steering down air spoke ship Jefferson lat 28° 9' long 121° 42' W

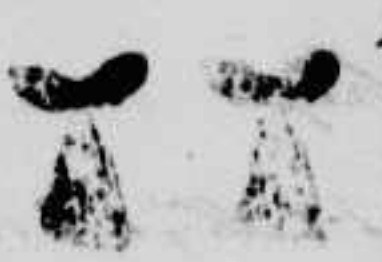
Tuesday May 10

Moderate trade winds by the wind middle and latter part the same lat 27° 4' long 120° 08' W

Wednesday May 11

Strong trades steering S by W middle and latter part the same lat 27° 4' long 120° 02' W

Thursday May 12



Strong trade winds steering S by W saw 2 whales lowerd did not get any saw more lowerd struck a calf and lat 27° 4'

Friday May 13

Moderate trade winds by the wind middle and latter part the same lat 27° 4' long 122° 50' W
