Sunday June 5, 1842

Strong trade winds steering S by W
middle and latter part the same but 13° S long 124° 47' W

Monday June 6

Moderate trades steering W middle and
latter part the same but 17° S long 130, 50' W

Tuesday June 7

Moderate trades steering W middle
and latter part the same but 18° S long 132, 14' W

Wednesday June 8

Strong trades steering S by W middle and
latter part the same but 21° S long 132, 04' W

Thursday June 9

Strong trades by the wind middle and
latter part the same but 25° S long 132, 14' W

Friday June 10

Strong trades steering S by W middle and
latter part the same but 28° S long 132, 27' W

Saturday June 11

Strong trades steering S by W spoke ship
H. Clay of U. S. Packet sends but 0000 long 132, 18' W

Sunday June 12

Moderate trades steering S middle and latter
part the same but 3° S long 132, 53' W

Monday June 13

Moderate trades by the wind middle and latter
part the same but 8° S long 131, 56' W

Tuesday June 14

Moderate trades by the wind middle and
latter part the same but 30° S long 130, 56' W

Wednesday June 15

Strong trades by the wind middle and
latter part the same but 2° S long 130, 05' W

Thursday June 16

Strong trade winds by the wind saw
a fin back going to windward
saw whale lower I struck 2 and raised
4 10 ends but 23° S long 128, 52' W

Friday June 17 1842

Strong trades by the wind but in the whale
saw more lower struck and saved 1 took
him to the ship latter part but him in and
commenced hauling Lat 70° S long 128, 33' W

Saturday June 18

Strong trade winds by the wind hauling
latter part finished hauling Lat 26° S long 128, 19' W

Sunday June 19

Strong trades by the wind middle and latter
part the same but 2° S long 127, 36' W

Monday June 20

Strong trade winds by the wind middle and
latter part the same but 5° S long 127, 04' W

Tuesday June 21

Strong trades by the wind 1 sail in sight
middle and latter part the same steamed
down sail Lat 11° S long 126, 29' W

Wednesday June 22

Strong trades by the wind 1 sail in sight
middle and latter part the same Lat 0000

Thursday June 23

Strong trade winds by the wind with a
heavy sea on 2 sail in sight spoke ship
H. Clay Capt. took it 31° S long 125, 33' W

Friday June 24

Strong trades by the wind middle and latter
part the same but 10° S long 125, 43' W

Saturday June 25

Strong trades steering S by W middle and latter
part the same but 22° S long 126, 11' W

Sunday June 26

Strong trade winds steering S by W
middle and latter part the same but 15° S long 126, 22' W

Monday June 27

Strong trades steering S by W spoke ship
Lucy Anna of Sydney got 2000 pounds and
Orant 20 ends but 15° S long 126, 25' W
