same with rain lat 5° 7' long 128° 33' W

Friday July 1, 1842

Strong trades steering S.W. W. raining
middle and latter part the same 2
ships in sight lat 3° 1' long 128° 28' W

Saturday July 2

Moderate trade winds steering S.W. W.
middle and latter part the same lat 5° 3' long 129° 10' W

Sunday July 3

Strong trade steering W.S.W. 1 ship in sight
middle and latter part the same lat 16° 3' long 129° 51' W

Monday July 4

Strong trades steering N.W. spoke Santa
Bliza of Salem middle and latter
part the same lat 8° 1' long 128° 28' W
same I W holes lower I struck and
killed 1 took him to the ship and
cut him in

Tuesday July 5

Strong trades spoke ship Phoenix
of St. Beaufort latter part saw 2 whales
lower and struck 2 and 1 then
got 2 ——— lat 10° 3'

Strong trades out in the whole
Barling middle and latter part
the same lat 8° 1' long 131° 54' W

in sight 4 mds lat 28° 1' long 131° 33' W

Monday July 11
