 Monday Sept 26
 Strong trade winds steering of W
 with rain squalls till midday heading
 S S E middle and latter part steering
 S S W lat 14° S Long 163,26 W
 Tuesday Sept 27
 Strong trade winds steering of W middle
 and latter part the same lat 13° S Long 164,08 W
 Wednesday Sept 28
 Strong trade winds steering of W middle
 and latter part heading S S W lat 12° S Long 164,36 W
 Thursday Sept 29
 Strong trade winds steering of W middle and
 latter part by the wind moderate
 lat 11° S Long 165,12 W
 Friday Sept 30
 Moderate trades by the wind saw Black fish
 middle and latter part the same lat 10° S
 Saturday Oct 1, 1842
 Moderate trades by the wind saw 4 whales
 lowered at 4 past 11:00 struck 1 killed and
 took him to the ship at 1:00 the latter part
 but him in now more whales going quick
 did not lose but 50 f
 Sunday Oct 2
 Moderate trades by the wind saw 4 whales
 going quick to windward lowered and
 not got away latter part saw more whales
 lowered got 1 took him to the ship and
 lat him in boiling lat 30° S
 Monday Oct 3
 Moderate trades saw 4 whales lowered
 and struck 3 killed 2 stove a Bad
 took them to the ship but them in
 boiling lat 1,06 S Long 165,00 W
