

Remarks on Board Bark Columbus

Sunday Oct 16, 1842

Moderate trades steering S W middle and latter part S long breezes by the wind lat 32 S long 185, 35 W

Monday Oct 17

Strong trades by the wind middle and latter part the same lat 30 S long 185, 19 W

Tuesday Oct 18

Moderate trade winds by the wind nothing in sight hard times middle and latter part the same lat 28 S long

Wednesday Oct 19

Moderate trades by the wind middle and latter part steering S W lat 25 S long 165, 39 W

Thursday Oct 20

Moderate trades steering S W middle and latter part steering N W lat 22 S long 166, 06 W

Friday Oct 21

Moderate trades saw 1 fish steering N W lat 19 S long 166, 19 W

Saturday Oct 22

Moderate trades steering N W middle and latter part steering S W lat 19 S long 168, 09 W

Sunday Oct 23

Moderate trades steering S W middle part steering N W saw 2 Whales going quick to the N W leeward and chased them 4 hours and not get any so ends lat 33 S long 169, 06 W

Monday Oct 24

Moderate trades by the wind middle and latter part the same saw an English Duck lat 30 S

Tuesday Oct 25

Moderate trades by the wind middle and latter part the same lat 28 S long 169, 08 W

Wednesday Oct 26

Strong trades by the wind middle and latter part the same lat 25 S long 169, 23 W

Thursday Oct 27, 1842

Strong trade winds by the wind fitting near Main top galleen rigging middle and latter part the same lat 22 S long 169, 46 W

Friday Oct 28

Strong trade winds by the wind middle and latter part the same saw 1 sail in sight to windward lat 39 S long 169, 32 W

Saturday Oct 29

Moderate trades by the wind middle and latter part the same spoke Bank Jaws of Land and gunning lat 32 S long 170, 06 W

Sunday Oct 30

Moderate trades rainy steering N W middle and latter part the same lat 1, 31 S

Monday Oct 31

Moderate trades by the wind saw 4 whales several struck 3 stove the 4th but the line of to N West took the boat to the West of a gale struck and drove middle and latter part then in commenced Boiling lat 1, 45 S long 170, 27 W

Tuesday Nov 1, 1842

Moderate trades Boiling by the wind middle and latter part the same lat 48 S

Wednesday Nov 2

Moderate trades by the wind saw 4 whales heard struck 1 but the line struck 3 more killed them took them to the ship & killed 1st middle part layed by them latter part but then in commenced Boiling lat 52 S long 170, 57 W

Thursday Nov 3

Moderate trades by the wind Boiling middle and latter part the same lat 48 S

Friday Nov 4

Moderate trades by the wind finished Boiling middle and latter part the same 1 sail in sight lat 1, 05 S long 171, 18 W
