Sunday Nov 20

Moderate winds from N. steaming to middle
and latter part calm Lat 10° 48' Long 174, 46 W

Monday Nov 21

Calm weather 1 ship in sight middle and
latter part the same spoke ship Leon
of Providence Lat 5° 4' Long 174, 56 W

Tuesday Nov 22

Moderate winds and no whales middle
and latter part the same steaming down
Oib Lat 33° 9' Long 175, 40 W

Wednesday Nov 23

Moderate trades by the wind fair in
night middle and latter part the same
with rain Lat 19° 8' Long 176, 00 W

Thursday Nov 24

Moderate trades by the wind saw some
kellers latter part saw 4 whales going
quick to toward struck and killed
I took them to the ship Lat 35° 9' Long 176, 20 W
