Wednesday March 18 1843

Strong winds from W steering
E by S with heavy rain squalls
sends Lat 23, 23 Long 139, 20 W

Thursday March 19

Moderate winds from W to E by S
wind moderate parts saw 4 whales lower
and struck 2 but 1 and the line
took the other to the ship and cut
him in sends Lat 23, 23 Long 138, 54

Friday March 20

Moderate winds from E by the wind
bailing middle and latter the same
finishing bailing Lat 23, 20 Long 138, 41 W

Saturday March 21

Calm with rain middle and latter
part the same sends Lat 23, 40 Long 138, 00 W

Sunday March 22

Strong breeze from E by the wind
sends Lat 24, 06 Long 137, 16 W

Monday March 23

Moderate winds from E by the wind
clear weather steering down all
sends Lat 23, 20 Long 137, 14 W

Tuesday March 24

Moderate winds from E by the wind
bad men island in sight finished
steering the fore hole middle and
latter part the same Lat 23, 15 Long 137, 10

Wednesday March 25

Moderate winds from E by the wind
middle and latter part the same
mending sail Lat 22, 47 Long 137, 00 W

Thursday March 26

Moderate winds from E by the wind
sends Lat 21, 40 Long 136, 17 W

Friday March 27

Moderate winds from E
by the wind middle part heard breakers
latter part made fisher in Lat 21, 18 Long 136, 40 W

Saturday March 25 1843

Moderate winds from E by the wind
latter part the same Lat 20, 30 Long 135, 40 W

Sunday March 26

Moderate winds from E by the wind
middle and latter part the same Lat 20, 00 Long 135, 00 W

Monday March 27

Moderate winds from E by the wind
raining saw a large whale going to
unaware and did not lower so ends
third 24 hours Lat 18, 12 Long 134, 41 W

Tuesday March 28

Strong whale seen traces by the wind
middle and latter part the same Lat 16, 30 Long 134, 08 W

Wednesday March 29

Strong trade winds by the wind middle
and latter part the same Lat 14, 45 Long 133, 50 W

Thursday March 30

Strong trade winds by the wind middle
and latter part the same Lat 12, 48 Long 132, 27 W

Friday March 31

Strong trade winds by the wind middle and
latter part the same Lat 10, 58 Long 132, 36 W

Saturday March 1, 1843

Strong trade winds by the wind middle and
latter part the same Lat 9, 10 Long 132, 00 W

Sunday April 2

Strong trade winds by the wind
saw six back middle and latter
part the same Lat 7, 14 Long 131, 53 W

Monday April 3

Strong trade winds by the wind middle
and latter part equally Lat 5, 20 Long 131, 20 W

Tuesday April 4

Strong and equally weather middle
and latter part the same
Lat 3, 30 Long 130, 27 W
