Saturday May 21st

Came in with strong gales from S.W. and rainy weather - Ship by the wind heading to the N.E.W. under easy sail watch employed in boiling and doing other work about ship - nothing in sight all day but one steamer going E. One man in blubber room cut his foot cutting blubber - nothing still off duty
 Lat at P. merid. 40 22
 Long by Chron. 62.47

Sunday May 22nd

Came in with gale of wind from the W. and rainy weather. Ship by the wind to the N.E.W. under easy sail watch employed in boiling - at 12 M. wind changed suddenly to the N. - wore ship heading N.E.W. nothing in sight
 Lat by Gal. 40 26
 Long by Chron. 63.12

Monday May 23rd

Came in with moderate breezes from the N. and fine pleasant weather - Ship all the A.M. steering W. per compass in the P.M. S.W. nothing in sight but two sail, and one or two Shetland Bottom. Finished boiling by 2 P.M. whales turning up on back 50 blb. - all day smoky and poor seeing get clear overhead
 Lat at P. merid 40.36
 Long by Chron. 63.50

New Bedford Outward Bound

Tuesday May 24th

Came in with quite clear weather but somewhat smoky wind from the S.E. and fresh - Ship by the wind to the S. and E. with all sail out - nothing in sight all the A.M. but two sail and one finback in the P.M. saw two sail and one finback and at 6 P.M. raised sperm whales going quite quick to the S.E. lowered all four boats and struck one to east but starboard Waist Boat lost large tub of line - Starboard Waist Boat lost a whale after killing him - Got all three of the whales alongside by 11 P.M. Lat of Whales 46 00
 Long by Chron. 63.15

Wednesday May 25th

Came in with strong gales from S.W. and hazy weather - at 4 A.M. commenced cutting - one of the whales parted the fletche chain and got adrift - secured him after much trouble and by 1 P.M. had them all cut in in the P.M. all hands employed in clearing away heads and boiling besides other jobs about ship - One sail in sight this P.M. several men crippled and unable to do much - 2nd mate cut night while in the boat got his finger badly mashed - one man today hurt badly if not broke one of his arms - and nothing still off duty
