 duty - only on duty

 Temp. 63 Long. 46.00

Thursday June 9th
 Comes in with moderate breezes from
 the W. and fine weather - Ship steer-
 ing E.S.E. per compass with all
 sail out. - One sail in sight in
 the morn. working to the W. - Water
 of a dark green all day - Saw
 finbacks and Sulphur Bottoms also
 One sail and a Steamer working W.
 a very few birds and a few Portuguese
 man of war. seen today
 Lat at merid 41.07
 Long. by Chron. 44.00

Friday June 10th
 Comes in with light baffling airs from
 the S.W. and cloudy weather - wind
 hauling to the S and E - Ship steer-
 ing S.E. by S with all sail out
 Nothing in sight all day but fin-
 backs and Sulphur Bottoms - wind
 in the P.M. to the N.E. and N.
 Ship all day working E. Lat 40.45
 Long 41.50

Bedford Outward Bound

Saturday June 11th
 Comes in with moderate breezes from
 the W. S.W. and cloudy weather - Ship
 steering E.S.E. per compass under easy
 sail cruising - nothing in sight but
 one or two finbacks - water blue
 and green alternately - No porpoises or
 birds or anything to indicate whales
 Lat at merid. 41.30
 Temp. 62 Long. by Chron. 39.45

Sunday June 12th
 Comes in with strong gales from the W.
 and overcast. Ship steering E per compass
 all day cruising - nothing in sight but
 finbacks and one school of porpoises
 Water quite green the most of the day
 Lat at merid. 42.26
 Long. by Chron. 37.00

Monday June 13th
 Comes in with strong gales from the W.
 S.W. and overcast - Ship steering E.
 per compass. with all prudent sail out
 nothing in sight all day but one school
 of porpoises and a few finbacks one school
 of blackfish - Lat at merid. 43.40
 Long. by Chron. 33.20

Tuesday June 14th
 Comes in with strong gales from the S.W.
 and cloudy weather - Ship cruising to the
 S.W. and E with all prudent sail
 out. Water green all day with a few
 Portuguese man of war - several schools
 of porpoises at 6 P.M. saw a school
 of small fish
 Lat at merid 44.28
 Long. by Chron. 31.20
